## **CRAFT “He is the Potter Clay Class”**

**AGE: 7-9**

**ESTIMATED LENGTH: 3 HOURS**

### **NEEDED MATERIALS:**

- Table Covers
- Clay
- Mix Media Art
- Paint
- Paint brush
- Water cup
- Styrofoam plate

### **INTRO AND CLASS SUMMARY:**

#### **Class begins:**

- Get started on their project
- Before they have their décor on it.....STOP the children

#### **How many people remembered to pray this morning?**

- Teacher says: Oh I forgot!
- Take a part of the clay off

#### **How many people remembered to Read the Bible this morning?**

- Teacher says: OOPS I over slept....I had to get to Creations.
- Chunk off another piece of clay
- Even if the kids did remember, have all kids do as you are doing

#### **When your mom asked you this morning if you brushed your teeth, did you ignore her?**

- Take off another chunk
- Your pottery is a mess.....
- The Lord is the Potter and we are the clay. Sometimes when we are working with clay we have to break it down and rebuild it exactly like we want it. And that is what the Lord has to do to us to get us to the place He wants us to be.
- It could be as simple as obeying your parents when they ask you to set out the trash.
- When you help your little brother pick up his toys...
- Now you can start rebuilding...

Paul said in the 9th chapter of Romans, “Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?” You didn't know that, did you? That's what the Scripture says.
