Class Lesson

- Good morning class! Today we are going to talk about something very exciting! The new Agapao Tablet Sponsorship!
- First, as a background, let's talk a little bit about the word 'Agapao'. Now, I'm sure many of you have heard Brother Branham use the word 'Agapao' on tape, but do you know what he is usually referring to when he uses the word, 'Agapao'? Yes, 'Agapao Love'.
- Brother Branham teaches us, that there are two categories or forms of love.
- One is 'phileo' love. It is an earthly love that you have for your friends or for your parents.
- The other is 'Agapao' Love. It is Love that comes from Above. It is Divine Love. This kind of Love is not jealous or boastful.
- Brother Branham said, "The love of God is called 'Agapao' which means, 'God's love'." (58-0519 - Life)
- Agapao Love will make you pray for someone who has done something not right towards you. With Agapao Love, you are more worried about their soul than retaliating to what they have done towards you even if it may have upset you!
- Let's turn to 1 Corinthians Chapter 13:1-8
- In this chapter, they use a translated word for love, called "charity."

Read 1 Corinthians Chapter 13:1-8

1 Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.
2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing.
3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing.
4 Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up,
5 Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;
6 Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;
7 Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.
8 Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.

- Amen! The Bible tells us perfectly about that pure Godly Love! It is not jealous; It is not boastful; It is not easily angered!
- With Agapao Love you are most worried about someone's soul. You are not worried about the earthly human emotions that we have, like getting angry.
- How many of you have heard about this new sponsorship project? Yes, many, if not all, of you have.
- The Agapao tablet sponsorship is a way to help send God's Message of the Hour all around the world, even into jungles, in a more efficient way.
- The Agapao Tablet is the most powerful tool for distributing the Message that the world has ever seen.
- You may be young, but you get a chance to be a part of this great missionary work for the Lord Jesus Christ!
- You may not be able to travel all across the world to help with the work, but there are still ways you can help with the tools that God has provided for this end time.
- Did you know Brother Branham said, "Anyhow, you can't visit every nation. You can send tapes to it." (63-0630M - The Third Exodus) How encouraging is that!



- Jesus is coming very soon and we want to do everything we can to be ready!

...so, God, let us take advantage and conserve the time. And we realize that it's—it's getting late, and we want everything that we can do, that's in our power, to get the work done for the Lord Jesus before He comes. Somehow, I kind of feel that He is waiting for us to—to finish the job.

- Praise the Lord! It is getting late and the Lord will be here soon. Let's do everything that we can to 'finish the job'!
- Let's learn a little bit more about this powerful tool and how it can help the Bride of Christ.
- First of all, how many of you have a 'Hero Tablet' at home? (Children raise hands) Well, did you know the Agapao Tablet is not the same as the Hero?
- The Agapao Tablet has been specially designed and made at the Voice of God Recordings, specifically for the Bride of Jesus Christ.
- Who remembers our SOTP Scripture and song for Revelation 10:7? Yes! It says " But in the days of the VOICE...". Let's recite it all together! (Class may sing also: But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets. Revelation 10:7)
- How important it must be to hear that Voice. We listen to a Voice, don't we? Yes, we sure do, on the tapes! Whose Voice did God choose to use to speak to us in this last day? Right, Brother Branham!
- What language does Brother Branham speak? Yes, English.
- Who in here can speak and understand English? (Students raise their hands) Yes, all of you do, but what if English was a foreign language to you and you could not understand it?
- Through the work of the Lord at Voice of God Recordings, 1,205 sermons are available in English, They are now being translated in about 70 different languages.
- On Branham.org in the multimedia section, you can listen to a tape of Brother Branham in 52 of those different languages!
- Could you imagine not being able to understand what Brother Branham was saying on tape?
- Not only that, but when there was a translated tape ready in your language for you to hear, it took a long time for it to get to you.
- Let's listen to a little portion of how our non-English speaking brothers and sisters listen to a tape. These tapes are called 'Gap Tapes'.

30 And now, in this, it doesn't exactly mean that I'm speaking this to this congregation present, but these tapes go around the world. They're translated in, practically, oh, a great deal of the languages, even into the heathen lands around the world. We send them tapes, free, on a society of the church. And they're translated. And all out through the jungles of Africa, and to India, and around the world, goes these tapes.

- You can hear how important these translations are to believers that cannot understand English! These tapes are twice as long as the normal tapes when it is just Brother Branham speaking, but they are able to hear God's Voice and understand in their own language what God has stored up for them!

(Older classes may read description of the Agapao Tablet, how it is made, how it is distributed, etc., on the website, time permitting.)

Imagine living in a place hard to get to, maybe a jungle or a forest. It would take a long time to get tapes and other Message material to you.

- Imagine living in an area where you had to travel miles and miles to be able to get an internet connection just to be able to download or to hear Brother Branham's tapes?
- The Agapao Tablet makes it easier for people experiencing these sort of situations. With the tablet, they will be able to have access to the Message of the hour no matter where they live!
- The Tablet now has Subtitle, a new software, which allows them to hear Brother Branham in real time, while they see the text scrolling in their own language. It usually takes listening to one to two Messages like this for them to get used to it, but for most people, it is much better than gapped tapes, which take at least twice as long to hear!
- The Agapao tablet also has the function of peer to peer sharing (MST, which means Message Sync Technology) that allows one tablet to update another tablet close by without an internet connection!
- The Tablets now have Message search in their own language, which is a huge new feature!
- Also, they will have access to Cub Corner, Lifeline, pictures of Brother Branham, and more, all on their Tablet.
- Who knows what the most valuable thing is in all the world? Yes, your soul! It is the only thing that has any real value to it.
- With the new sponsorship project, you have an opportunity to send Agapao Tablets to believers all over the world so they may hear God's Voice and their soul can be fed with God's stored up food for this last day!

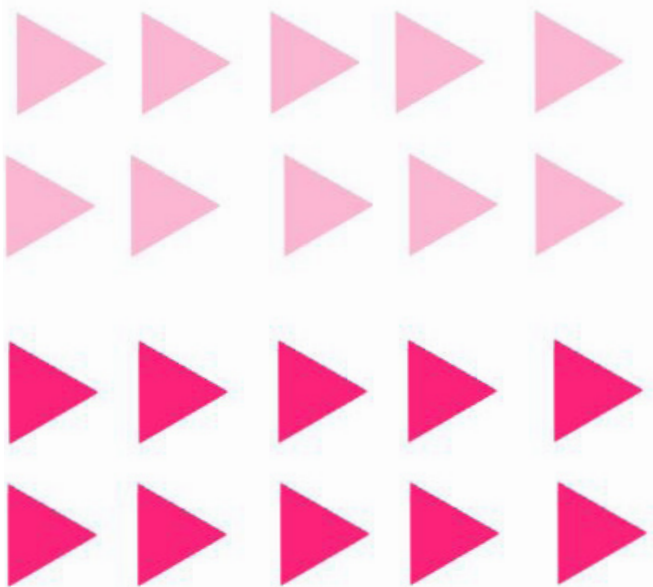
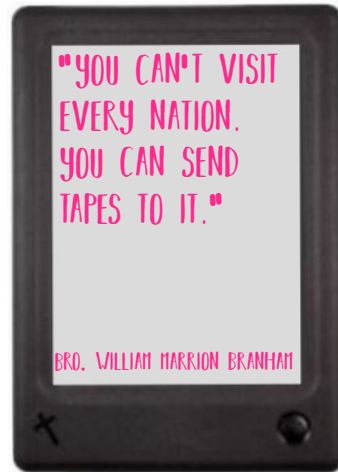
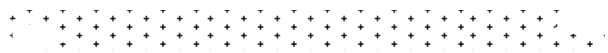
Play Quote 3:

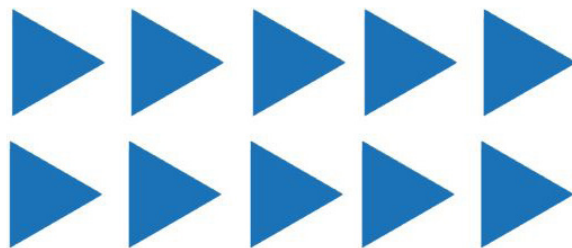
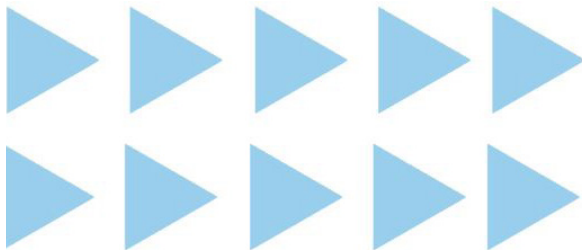
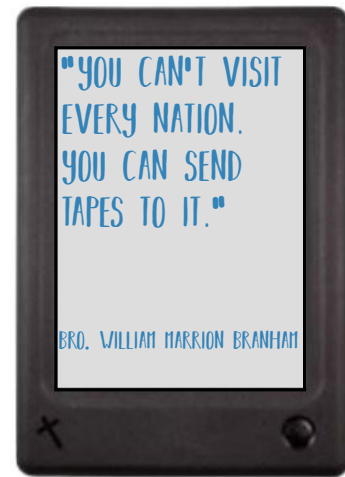

When you open the booklet and click print:

1. Make sure the pages are "sized to fit"
2. Select "print on two sides, flip on the long edge"
3. Print the pages.

When the booklet pages have printed, trim away the white and cut the sheets in half horizontally. Last, stack the pages in order and staple in the center. You now have your own Agapao booklet!

What you will need:

1. Glass Jar with lid
2. Mod Podge
3. Project Print-offs (already cut out)
4. Paintbrush
5. Scissors

You can find a Press Play Jar just like we used by going to www.ideastage.com and searching for Triangle-Glass-Jar-Small-Empty

Use your paintbrush to apply an even coat of mod podge to the back of each cut out when you are placing it.

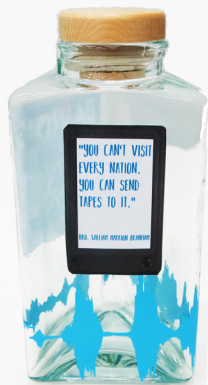
First, apply the sound wave cut out of Brother Branham saying "You can't visit every nation. You can send tapes to it." to the bottom of your jar.

The second step is to add the name tag. You could print your name and mod podge it to the label, or even use paint or sharpies to write it.

The Agapao tablet is the third piece to glue in place.

4



"Finish the Job" and "Press Play" go together for step four.

5



Scatter the "press plays" around the jar.

6



Place the five "passport stamps."

7



Mod Podge the world sticker to the lid of your jar.

You finished the jar!
