

Topic:

Jesus teaching at the temple; Fig tree is withered

Scriptures:

- Mark 11:20-24 (Brother Branham reads)
- Luke 19:47-48

Quote:

“And we want to think of that now as we read His Word. Turn with me to Mark the 11th chapter, and let’s begin reading at the 20th verse of Mark the 11th chapter. And as you’re—waiting for you to turn, I’ll give you the back part of the lesson. Jesus had just went up to the temple. And on His road up He went into the temple, and begin to drive out the people from changing—money changers and doing things that wasn’t right, and told them that it is written, that God’s house was a house of prayer. But they’d made it a den of thieves, robbers, and misused God’s house. And then when He was going He found a fig tree the next morning. That he had leave—the tree had leaves on it, and He thought perhaps there would be some figs. So He went to get some figs. And there was no figs on it, because it wasn’t season yet. And He said to the tree, “No man eateth from thee from henceforth forever.” And here’s where we start now to read at the 20th verse.

And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.

And Peter calling to remembrance said unto Him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursed in the way, is wi—thou cursed is withered away.

And Jesus answering said unto them, Have faith in God.

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them.”
