It’s the same for spiritual Food. We constantly hunger for more of God’s Word, so we must constantly eat from His Word to get filled up. If we don’t eat, we starve.




PLACE MAT TUTORIAL





PRESS FABRIC. 1.



CENTER THE WRONG SIDE OF ONE PIECE OF FABRIC OVER THE FUSIBLE SIDE OF THE FLEECE. 2.



PRESS THE FABRIC ON TOP OF THE FLEECE. DO NOT IRON THE FLEECE SIDE. 3.




PIN THE FABRIC WITH FLEECE TO THE OTHER FABRIC, RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER, MATCHING THE EDGES. 4.



SEW AROUND THE EDGES USING A 1/2" SEAM ALLOWANCE. LEAVE A 4" OPENING. 5.



CLIP THE CORNERS, BEING CAREFUL NOT TO CUT THE SEAM. 6.



TURN THE PLACE MAT RIGHT SIDES OUT. PUSH OUT THE CORNERS AND PRESS. 7.



TURN UNDER THE OPENING EDGES AND PIN. TOP STITCH USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE. 8.
