TUTORIAL

MATERIALS NEEDED:

assorted wood
wood glue
finish (we used mineral oil)

TOOLS NEEDED:

safety glasses
clamps
measuring tape
pencil
sand paper
pin nail gun
table saw

CUT LIST:

sides: 2 pieces 10" wide x 5 1/2" long x 3/4" thick

front: 1 piece 4" wide x 8 1/4" long x 3/4" thick

back: 1 piece 4" wide x 10" long x 3/4" thick

top and bottom: 2 pieces 4" wide x 4" long x 3/4" thick

cover: 1 piece 7" wide x 7" long x 3/4" thick


book ledge: 1 piece 3/8" wide by 5" long by 1/4" thick

*Parental assistance recommended.



1.

Make sure all the sides of the pieces are square.



2.

Cut one side of both side pieces at a 21 degree angle, making the highest point 10" and the lowest point about 8".



3.

Cut a 21 degree angle on the top edge of both top and bottom pieces.



4.

Glue and pin nail the two sides in between the front and back pieces. All the pieces should be flush on all sides.



5.

Glue and pin nail the bottom piece into the hole in the bottom of the box.



6.

Glue and pin nail the top piece centered on the cover piece, leaving a 1 1/2" perimeter around the top piece.

Measure and mark 1" in on both sides and 1/2" up from the bottom of the front of the cover piece.

7.



Glue and pin nail the book ledge to this mark.

8.



9.

Sand down the entire project.



10.

Apply finish.
