Scripture:

That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:

II Peter 3:2

Quote 2:

“The sunlight is sent to the earth, in the natural, to ripen the grain for the advancing harvest. Each day brings forth a new sun. The sun that’s shining today, bringing the wheat up, in Canada; that same sun, well, if it hadn’t... didn’t have no more sun than that, this coming July or August, it could never ripen the grain. It’s got to be stronger and more powerful, each day it grows and matures, to bring the grain on.

Now if the grain, itself, if it begins to mature, the grain comes on, if it stays right with the grain, it only builds the grain. Each day, the husk around it, the--the part calcium and whatever goes in it, builds right into the grain, as the sun gets stronger.

But you take the sun that shines in August, and put it on the wheat today, it would kill it. Certainly, you can’t do that. It must come in its season. So must God’s wheat and grain ripen just in the season, the season it’s in. But how could a sun... Well, a wheat would die, the fruits would die, by the sun that lives today, that shines today, rather. Its oncoming harvest is ripening.

Lesson:

We want to talk today about being “MINDFUL”. What does it mean to be mindful? When you’re mindful of someone or something, how would you be?

If you’re mindful of someone, you might do something that you know really means a lot to them. Your mind is on what you are doing for that person, and it most likely will mean a lot to them that you were thinking of them. It shows that you love and care for them. Also, if you’re mindful of your parents, you listen and do what they ask you. You’re being obedient.

Many Bible heroes have examples and testimonies that show us they were mindful of God and how God blessed them and took care of them.

Brother Branham talks of the Shunamite woman in the Bible and how she was mindful. He said, “she was very MINDFUL of a preacher.” Does anyone know who this preacher was? It was Elisha.

Candle

TUTORIAL

MATERIALS NEEDED



Steps:

1. Hot glue the wick to the bottom center of the candle jar.
2. Put Mod Podge on the bottom section of your jar.
3. Place one end of the yarn at the bottom of the jar. Hold that end firmly and begin wrapping the jar.
4. Once you get the desired amount of that yarn on your jar, stop and cut the yarn. Be sure that you stop on the same side of the jar you started on.
5. Keep placing Mod Podge and decorating your jar however you like.
6. Finish wrapping the jar completely, ending at the top.
7. Place the pot on a small burner and pour in the wax.
8. The wax melts quickly, be sure to stir continuously.
9. After the wax is completely melted, add in candle fragrance.
10. Pour the wax into the candle jar.
11. Wrap the wick around the pencil and rest on the top of the jar. This will keep your wick straight.
12. Let the candle sit for 24 hours. The candle should be completely hard.
13. Remove the pencil and trim the wick.
14. Enjoy your candle!
