# TRACT HOLDER TUTORIAL

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

assorted wood  
wood glue  
finish (we used mineral oil)

## TOOLS NEEDED:

safety glasses  
clamps  
measuring tape  
pencil  
sand paper  
coping saw  
table saw  
miter saw  
bandsaw

## CUT LIST:

front and back: 2 pieces 2 1/2" wide x 3 3/4" long x 3/16" thick  
side dividers: 2 strips 3/16" x 3/16" x 3 3/4" long  
back divider: 1 strip 3/16" x 3/16" x 2 1/8" long

\*Parental assistance recommended.



1.

Mark and cut a thumb-groove from the top piece.

Glue the side and back dividers flush around the edges of the bottom piece. Wipe off any excess glue.

2.

Glue the top piece to the dividers, creating a sandwich. Clamp together.

4.

Wipe off any excess glue inside and out. Tip: you can use an old card to clean the excess glue out from the inside.

5.

After the glue is dry, sand the project.

Apply finish.
