JUDGES

$\mathbf{T}^{ ext{HERE}}$ was once a time in the history of the israelite people

when there was no prophet in the land. The Word of God was very rare, so the people just did what they thought was right in their own sight. They didn't have all of God's Word, like we have today, to tell them the true and right way of God. But they did have "judges."

The judges were men and women who God set in order to lead the Israelites.

They were ordained by God to play their roles as leaders of His people.

The judges were like political leaders of today, kind of like a mayor or governor. They judged the acts of the people and made decisions about the future of Israel. Some judges, like Deborah, led the Israelites to war, and another judge, Samson, used the power of God to single-handedly kill thousands of Philistines, Israel's enemy.

It must have been a really hard time for the Israelites. The entire Bible had not yet been written, and probably only a few priests ever got to read the laws of Moses. The people of Israel needed leadership, and the judges were who God sent to them.

Aren't you thankful that in this day we not only have the Bible to read, but also a prophet to tell us the ways of God! We are very blessed, that's for sure. God has given us all the tools we need to know all about Him. It is up to us to use these tools; we should read our Bibles, pray, and listen to Brother Branham as much as we can!



Greetings in the Name of Christ Jesus our Lord! I love reading the animal stories in the Cub Corner and always wanted something to add.







CARIBOU

LOOK AT THE CARIBOU'S BEAUTIFUL WINTER SNOW PLOWING HOOVES, IT BECOMES THAT GOD CREATED THESE ANIMALS FOR THE COLD ARCTIC!

Way up north, in the cold arctic circle, caribou roam the land in massive herds.

They are designed to travel long distances, miles per year! That sounds like a really long walk, but their long legs, warm coat, and oversized hooves are up for the task.

On their long journey, adult caribou must watch out for bears, wolves, and coyotes. The baby caribou,

or "calves," also have to look out for golden eagles and wolverines.

During the warmer months, one of their

biggest concerns is mosquitos. Those annoying little insects come by the millions in the far north, and they can make a

> massive herd of thousands of caribou move miles out of their way. Not bad for a tiny little

walkin'

Caribou don't have feet like you and I. They have special hooves that really come in handy. These hooves are really big and have sharp outer edges. They help them from sliding around on the ice and rocks. On the down-side, it pretty much ruins their chances of ever being able to wear cool shoes.

diggin'

If you looked at the underside of a caribou's hooves, you would notice that it is hollowed out like a scoop. This helps the caribou to dig down in the snow to find food.

swimmin'

Caribou travel great distances while migrating. Sometimes large rivers or lakes have to be crossed to continue their journey. The hollowed out hooves act like big paddles and help them to swim really well.
