Have you ever thought about why people who live in the most remote regions of the world, who have never heard about Jesus, still worship? They have never learned about God creating the heavens and the earth, or Moses parting the Red Sea, or even about Jesus dying on the cross, but they worship god anyway. Many of them worship the sun, or the moon, or even animals as their gods, but they still worship. No one ever told them to start worshipping, but they do anyway. I wonder why.

## Brother Branham said:

"Fore that creation can be in there, that creation to make you desire that, there has to be a Creator to create that creation. Is that right? Well, there's got to be God then somewhere, that's putting that desire in your heart to desire that. And if He has put that desire there, then there's got to be something out there to fulfill that desire that you got. Do you see? The deep calling to the deep..."

Just like when you get hungry and need to eat, the need to worship is also in you. God put it there, because He wants us to worship Him. The word "god" actually means, "an object of worship."

We should trust God for everything, ask Him for our healing when we are sick, trust Him to provide the things we need, and believe that He forgives our sins. We know that He will take care of us and keep us safe, and protect the people we love. He wants us to ask for those things, but remember, that's not why He created us. He made us to worship Him. As you go through your day, don't forget your main job = worship God.


You think about Him all the time, tell Him you love Him, you read His Word, and you read His Voice.

You can also worship God by singing to Him, talking about
Him, looking for Him, and praying to Him.

God loves you and He wants you to show Him that you love Him back. Remember, that's why He created you.
