"The Message Is Still Alive"


Hello, I wanted to tell you about something that I hope will remind you about how Brother Branham's Message is still alive today.

"A Very Present Help"






one he has seen survive the surgery. She believes in God and so she knows that God hetped her through that, and that God still has a purpose for her down here on earth.


The fire raged as the king's mighty men approached the furnace with their calm prisoners. The fire was so hot that as the guards threw the Hebrews in, the fire killed the guards!

y name is Daniel, and I want to tell you a small part of my story.


