












# Formay Crow



It wasn't long ago that the Soviet Union was controlled by a godless form of government called communism. They didn't allow people to freely believe and worship God but they still **couldn't stop the Word**.

In the small country of Holland, God called a little missionary family, named the Buitenkamp's. Led by Brother Heino Buitenkamp, this believing family would dedicate their lives to leading people to Christ. Brother Gerald Buitenkamp, Brother Heino's son, now manages the VGR European office with help from his wife and sons, Brother Timothy, Brother Matthew, and Brother Benjamin. They have hundreds of missionary stories they could share, these are only a few of them:

"I remember some outstanding times how we had to cross those border check points. I always thought, "How would we ever get through all these check points." On many trips, dad pulled a trailer loaded with all the translated messages, and managed to get through the quards by having a bunch of goodies like chocolate, candy, coffee and fruit. I remember how he had to teach them to peel an orange; some had never seen one before. Back in those days, it was hard to get any of those products, for those who lived in the ooor countries of Eastern Europe.

These things were kind of the bait on the hook to give the border guards the delicious goodies from the west that they normally could not get. Dad always found a way to get border guards to let us through and take the attention away from the precious cargo of the Message, which is what it was all about.

I remember as the work grew, Bro. Joseph asked me to work for VGR at the European office. He decided to ship us a Ford pick-up

truck, a very rare thing in Eastern Europe. The Lord provides you with the right tools that you need to get the work done when you surrender everything to Him. This truck had plenty of space to carry the big loads of material that we needed to bring to all these eastern countries. I usually took my entire family, including all three boys who were very young at the time, on my trips. When loading the material, we put all the tapes and books in the bed of the truck, then put our luggage on top of it. Next, we would stack on farm produce like potatoes, tomatoes, tomato plants, and used clothes to give to the poor. I would hang my fishing poles on the side of the camper shell and sometimes even pulled a small trailer that could bring another load of tapes and hooks.

Every trip would usually be about 3,000 miles; about equal to a one way trip from coast to coast in the U.S. We usually loaded a rubber raft with oars on top of the trailer to make it look like we were happy campers! And we sure were!

When we arrived at the border, the custom guards would normally check our passports first, then take a good look at the vehicle. Of course it looked totally different from any vehicle they had ever seen. As they inspected the back, where all the Message material was, they saw all the farm produce and asked if everything in the back was food. I always replied, "yes," knowing that most of it was Spiritual Food!

Of course the border patrol saw that we had our fishing gear and portable barbecue in the truck with a rubber raft on top of the trailer we were pulling. Time after time they would ask if we were going fishing. Again, I replied, "Yes sir!" Knowing in my heart that we were fishing for men! It was the bait on the hook! "Take no thought of what you will have to say for He will give you the right words to speak!"

I remember another occasion that the border guards asked me to see the cab and engine of the truck. His first reply was, "wow this is like an airplane!" I offered him a ride across the border and gave him the front seat. He was so excited to have a little ride in an American vehicle that he forgot all about checking to see what was in the back of it! I popped the hood and showed him the engine which took all attention away from the precious cargo that was stored in the back.

Another time I remember arriving at the Romanian border with the red truck. Customs were stopping every vehicle, even the Red Cross. When we arrived we were the only truck that was waved right on through. Everybody else had to unload everything out of their vehicle

The Lord surely took care of us in many ways to get the stored up

Food to His people. You can imagine the look on the believers'

look in their eyes; how happy they were to get ahold of these

look in their eyes; how happy they were to get ahold of these new translated messages that came from the storehouse in Jeffersonville.

These are only a few stories of how the Lord has helped our little missionary family. If you think that you would like to be a missionary, I would advise you to always keep in the Word, and start in your own backyard. Witness to your neighbors, or anyone else the Lord leads you to. The key is to be

# GIOEOM

In the Old Testament Book of Judges, we learn the story of a poor farmer named Gideon.

ne day, Gideon was threshing wheat, while trying to hide it from the thieving Midianites. He knew that whatever they saw, they would steal. They had enemies all around them, ones that weren't afraid to attack them whenever they saw something they wanted.

Then suddenly, Gideon saw the Angel of the Lord standing under an oak tree. The angel said, "The Lord is with thee, thou mighty man of valour."

Gideon replied, "Oh my Lord, if the Lord be with us, why then is all this befallen us? and where be all his miracles which our fathers told us of..."

The Angel told Gideon that God had chosen him to smite the Midianites! Gideon couldn't believe it, he was a nobody; he came from a poor family, and he was the least of all of them. Gideon needed a sign from God, so the Angel told him what to do to receive

his sign. Gideon soon returned with exactly what the Angel said. He was to bring back a meal of young goat and unleavened cakes. He laid it upon a rock just as the

Angel instructed. Then Gideon got his sign.
The Angel touched the offering with the end of his staff and fire rose up out of the rock and consumed the meat and bread! Suddenly the Angel was gone.

Time went on, and Gideon realized that God truly had chosen him to fight the Midianites.

He continued to do exactly as God told him, and God continued to show Gideon signs that He was with him.

Soon, Gideon had a huge army with him. Surely God had blessed him and prepared him for a great battle and victory, but things weren't going to happen exactly like Gideon thought they would.

You see, God wants people to understand just how powerful He really is. If Gideon's army was too big, the people would've thought they won the battle on their own, without God's help. So God decided to take the huge army and make it small. He knew that He could trust Gideon to do exactly what He said, so He told him to ask every soldier if he was scared. Those who said yes got to return home. Those who weren't scared, stayed. Gideon's army quickly shrank from 32,000 soldiers to only 10,000. But God wasn't done yet.



Next, God told Gideon to bring his whole army down to the water for a drink. Gideon watched as each one quenched his thirst. Almost all of them got down on their knees and drank directly from the water, while just a few cupped the water into their hands to drink. Gideon separated the two groups. Those who got on their knees would go back to the camp, while those who cupped the water would stay and fight. Only 300 men of Gideon's army remained! God had taken Gideon's army down from 32,000 soldiers to only 300! But God had a plan.

Gideon divided his 300 remaining men into three groups of 100. Instead of some new, super weapon, Gideon gave each man a trumpet and a pitcher with a torch in it. How would they fight thousands of Midianites with trumpets, pitchers, and torches?

Finally, Gideon gave everyone their orders. They were to surround the enemy's camp in the middle of the night and all at one time blow on their trumpets as loud as they could. At the same time, they would break their pitchers and reveal the torch that was inside.

When the Midianites heard the trumpets and saw the torches, they were terrified. Thousands and thousands of frightened Midianites fled as fast as they could. They were certain that they were defeated.

Israel rallied around Gideon and defeated the fleeing Midianites. God had once again showed how powerful He was, and He did it with only 300 soldiers and one faithful leader.


ALLS OF THE OHIO RIVER JEFFERSONVILLE IN

it wouldn't go. The Ohio Falls were getting closer and closer. If his little boat were to go over the falls, it would be certain death.






Last march we had an activity for our Sunday school kids. I am sending you pictures.


Sunday school activity of the Shawinigan, Québec, Canada, Young Bride of Christ from
