



He got on the plank and


rode down the whole thing without falling off! All the other boys gathered around him to ask him how he did it.

1/2 cup canned peach or pear nectar (available in supermarkets) 1 cup orange juice

1/2 cup vanilla ice cream

1/2 cup vanilla yogurt

1 teaspoon lime juice





Here is an easy, but delicious recipe! Just mix everything except the peanuts together until it is nice and smooth. Then mix in the peanuts and enjoy!






Elisabeth And John The Baptist






John and Jesus

Ice cream flavors in Costa Rica are interesting and sometimes ICE CREAM:

Flavors include coconut, goat cheese, wild blackberry, peanut, sour cream, chipotle blueberry, chocolate almond, and more.




There are about 750,000 species of insects that live in Costa Rica, including about 20,000 different types of spiders!
