

There was once a mighty prophet named Elijah. He was a mysterious man of God that seemed to come out of nowhere. We don't know anything about his past, or what his childhood was like, but we do know that God used him in great and powerful ways.

Elijah lived during the reign of King Ahab and his evil wife, Jezebel. Ahab and Jezebel did not follow the ways of God, and God punished them for it.

One time, everything came to a showdown on a mountain named Mt. Carmel. Elijah challenged the prophets of Baal, and God proved that He was the One true and living God. After God made Himself known, Elijah killed the godless prophets of Baal.

Jezebel was furious! She proclaimed that God's prophet Elijah would die!

Elijah fled from everyone. He went out into the wilderness, sad and alone. He felt like he had failed God, and he couldn't go on any longer.

If you get quiet and listen to Him, you will hear Him. He speaks to your heart. You can hear Him talking to you if you just take the time to listen. Go without all of the distractions of the world, get alone with God, and ask Him to speak to you. Then listen for that still, small Voice.







SAMUEL

There was once a godly woman named Hannah who wanted a child more than anything in the world.

She knew that if God would ever give her a baby, she would do whatever she could to make sure he was raised for God. She was desperate, until one day, God answered her prayer and gave her the little boy that she had wanted so badly. God had given Hannah an extra special gift, her son wasn't just any regular child, he was born to be a prophet of God. She named her little prophet-son, Samuel. Hannah kept her promise to God and sent Samuel to be raised in the temple by the priest, Eli.

When Samuel was still a young boy in the temple, he was laying asleep when he heard a Voice call out, "Samuel, Samuel." Samuel quickly went to the priest, Eli, to see what he wanted. But it wasn't Eli who was calling him.

BROTHER BRANHAM finally headed back to the hotel, but God still had some more appointments for







God speaks to us just like He spoke to Elijah; with a still, small Voice. It's up to us to listen to it.


Imagine being in a noisy room with a lot of people talking. Some of them are talking to you, and some are talking to each other. You are trying to listen


to all of them, but you can only focus on one person at a time. You can hear everyone, but you really can't understand anyone. It would be pretty hard to have an important conversation with a good friend in a loud place like that.

Now imagine being in a nice, quiet place. There's only one other person with you, and he has something important to tell you. There are no people or other distractions around you. Your toys and games are put away. There are no TVs, video games, movies, cell phones, or anything else to steal your attention away from the person talking to you. Everything is focused on your conversation. You hear every word he says to you, and you have time to speak back to him.

Sometimes we put ourselves in the noisy, crowded room, and we try to listen to God in there. The problem is that God is speaking quietly and everyone else is really loud. It seems like every now and then you hear a Word or two of what He is saying, but it is nearly impossible to hear everything.

Wouldn't you like to ask God to leave the noisy room with you, and come out to a nice quiet spot where you can sit down alone with Him? Well, you can.
