



Yup, people 60-0306 IT WASN'T SO FROM THE BEGINNING make it happen by "grafting." That's when a branch from one tree is cut off and stuck into a different tree. You can put a pear branch into an apple tree, and that branch will grow pears. The new pear branch lives off the life of the apple tree it is grafted into. But it is very important to remember that if the original apple tree ever grows a new branch, it will grow apples - because it's an apple tree to begin with!

Brother Branham compares grafting to the way a lot of groups live off God's Spirit, but they are not really part of God. They are like a gourd branch that gets grafted into a grape vine. They can survive off the life of the Vine, but if that Grape Vine (Jesus) ever puts out a new branch of its own, it will produce grapes, not gourds. We want to be part of that original Tree, not just a grafted branch. Then we will produce the real fruits of the Spirit.




Just like the apple tree, you produce fruits too, but instead of producing apples or oranges, your fruits are the way you act.



The difference is that a real Christian produces those fruits from inside, but the devil fakes them.

So always think about what type of fruit you are producing. Do people look at you and see love, joy, and faith? If not, ask God to change you. He will do it!

The next time the devil tempts you and you don't want to do what's right, just remember what kind of tree you are, and show the devil your Christian fruits!

I guess we'll just have to wait and see.


BREAKING NEWS:

God gave Satan power over everything that belonged to Job, because He knew that His servant was faithful and full of longsuffering, and would never curse God.



One of the fruits of the Spirit is "meekness." Do you know what it means to be meek? Here is a story of one woman who was very meek, and Jesus rewarded her for it.

Two thousand years ago, when Jesus was walking the earth, there was a woman whose daughter had an "unclean spirit." Brother Branham said the girl was probably an epileptic (a person who has seizures), or she had some sort of insanity. She was really sick, and her mommy was desperate for help.

The girl's mother heard that Jesus was at a certain house, so she frantically found her way to Him. She knew that Jesus could heal her daughter, if He would just speak the Word!

When she saw Him, she must have known that everything would be okay. She was standing face to face with God in human flesh! She cried out to Him, "O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil." But Jesus didn't answer her, in fact, He completely ignored her. The disciples came to take her away, but Jesus finally answered, "I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel." He was telling her that God did not send Him for her and her people.

How disappointed she must have been. She could have just cried and walked out, or got mad and said something mean to Jesus. Instead, she cried out to Him, saying "Lord, help me."

But just wait...






Follow the steps below and build your very own pyramid!

glue


STEP 1

Draw a square on a thick piece of construction paper. You can use a small box to help you if you need to.



STEP 2

Draw new corners to make triangles coming from each side of the box. Hint: make each side of your triangle the length of the sides of the box.



STEP 3

Draw small flaps off each corner of your new square. Later you will fold these flaps and use glue on them to help hold your pyramid up.

STEP 4 Cut around the outside of your drawing.




STEP 5

Fold flaps on dotted lines, then fold triangles into pyramid shape.



STEP 6

Use glue on the flaps to secure the pyramid together. After the glue has dried, use a marker to decorate your pyramid.


