

Play these games in Sunday School, or at home with your family.


## Gamel

## denture donkeys

Technically this is called a single horned Texas donkey, but they are more commonly known as denture donkeys. They have huge buck teeth, and a strange horn that always grows in place of their right ear.

## elephant seal

Elephant seals are seals that get their name from their large nose that looks like an elephant's trunk. Notice that they don't have ears! They live near the ocean and are great swimmers. At one point they were almost hunted into extinction, but now their numbers are doing really well.





## **barsier**

These small primates are found in Southeast Asia. Each eye of the tarsier is as large as its brain! Is that what your eyes look like when you see dessert coming?

Tarsiers are really small. Their bodies are only 4-5 inches long, but their hind legs are nearly 10 inches when they are unfolded. Their springy legs make them great jumpers, which helps catch insects, lixards, and even bats!

## ebbalonei

The fastest moving of the turtle family, the ebbaloney has feet that look like a cat's feet more than a typical turtle's. It scoots along about twice as fast as the average turtle, but pays for it with it's inability to swim.

They seem like they would make great pets, but attempts to domesticate them have failed miserably, mostly due to their very short temper and sharp claws.

# Cooked dough

## INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup of flour
- 1/2 cup of salt
- 2 tbsp of cream of tartar
- 1 cup of water
- 1 tbsp cooking oil Food coloring



## STEPS:

- 1. In a pot, mix together the flour, salt, and cream of tartar. Stir in the water and oil.
- 2. Cook the mixture over medium-to-low heat, stirring constantly. When the mixture is thick and smooth, turn off the stove and remove the pot.
- 3. Spoon the play dough out onto a counter that's dusted with flour. Allow it to cool for a few minutes.
- 4. Divide the dough into two or three balls. Knead a different food coloring into each ball until the color is even. If the dough gets sticky, mix in a bit more flour.
- 5. Store each color of dough in a separate plastic bag when you aren't playing with it, and it will keep for months!

## #2 Uncooked dough

### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup of flour 1/4 cup of salt
- 1/2 cup of water

## STEPS:

- 1. In the bowl, stir together the flour and salt. Then add the water.
- 2. Mix the dough with your hands. If it does not hold together, add a little more water. If it is sticky, add a little flour. The dough is right when it does not stick to your hands.
- 3. Divide the dough into two or more balls. Mix a few drops of food coloring into each ball. For a marbled look, only mix the ball up a little bit.
- 4. If you are not going to use the dough right away, store it in a separate plastic bag. It will last in the fridge for one to two weeks.



King Uzziah may not have even known it at the time, but the young king had someone very important watching him.

Isaiah the prophet was younger than King Uzziah, and he looked up to the godly king. Soon the two would become good friends.

Sometimes Isaiah would even go to the castle to stay with King Uzziah. Together, they would go to the temple and pray, and ask the will of the Lord for their people. They both knew that they were special people, who were chosen by God to lead the people of Judah.

King Uzziah's fame spread all over the land. His people loved him and his enemies feared him!





hen one day everything changed. Uzziah got too proud and did something terribly wrong.


If you ever feel like you are not serving God the way you should be, just do what Josiah did; get back in the Word of God!




