"And there, that great space where no one can fathom in their mind beyond that, that space, eternity." 50-0815


We think that you are right about Satan. We would like to knock him out of his mind too! Let's just keep punching him with the Word! Thanks, Olivia.

Located about 40 miles northeast of Tucson, Sunset Mountain is out in the middle of nowhere. It has rocky ridges that look over dry, sandy river beds, or "washes." It is a beautiful spot in the desert that none of us would have ever heard of, if God had not chosen it as a special place for His prophet.

Step 5: Attach the two big roof boards.


Step 6: Cover the gap in the roof with the top board.

Little did they know that Patmos would be the perfect place for God to speak to His prophet.

Patmos was a rough, rocky island that was full of snakes, lizards, and scorpions. It wasn't exactly a nice place to live; it was a tough prison.

John could have felt sorry for himself; he was separated from everything that he had. His whole life was left behind, and he was stuck on this island.

But John didn't get down, he got in the Spirit. God spoke to him and told him to write down the things he heard and saw.

John heard about the end of the world, and what the end time would be like. He wrote it all down, just as he was commanded.

While on the island, John continued to see visions and Angels. He saw hidden things that were to be kept secret until the end time. The scrolls he wrote on are what we now call the Book of Revelation.

You can read what John wrote down while he was on the island of Patmos. The Book of Revelation is the last book of the Bible. It is very interesting, but to really understand what it means, you will need to listen to God's prophet. You can hear Brother Branham talk about John on "The Patmos Vision" 60-1204E

HORSE




