MICAIAH PROPHET

In the days of King Ahab, there lived a PROPHET NAMED MICAIAH. The king and his friend, Jehoshaphat, were planning a battle against the Syrians. Ahab asked his 400 prophets if they should fight this battle. All of them said "yes."

King Jehoshaphat was still a little nervous, so he asked Ahab if there was a prophet of the Lord that they could consult. Ahab answered, "there is one more, but I hate him."

THAT MAN WAS MICATAH THE PROPHET, AND HE HAD THE WORD OF GOD.

When the king's messengers talked to MICAIAH, they tried to tell him what to say. They told him to tell Ahab to go into battle. Micaiah But knew better: he had THE WORD OF THE LORD and knew that Ahab would die if he fought the battle.


When they brought Micaiah in front of the two kings, he must have been under a lot of pressure, because

everyone there was BUT against him. MICAIAH DIDN'T CARE. When he told Ahab not to fight the Syrians, the king got so mad that he threw Micaiah into prison. Micaiah could have said sorry to King Ahab, and went along with the others, but he didn't. He would rather DO WHAT GOD SAID.

What do you think happened to Ahab when he ignored the messenger of the Lord? Did God honor Ahab's 400 men? Or did God honor the Word of His prophet? You can find out by reading 1st Kings, Chapter 22.

Young Sister Shearmay, also from the Philippines, says that she ate cooked banana and rice for lunch today. What did you have?








Hey look, a walking pine-cone! Nope, this is called a pangolin. They live in Angola. They eat ants and termites and can grow 3 feet long!


he kept flying, and finally he made it. He was crippled, wounded, broken, and bruised, but he fell into the camp with the message to help the trapped soldiers.

Because the little pigeon sacrificed its life, the other soldiers got help and were rescued from the Germans. They would've died if it hadn't been for the courageous pigeon.



1/2 cup of milk I cup of sliced peaches


I tsp. sugar

- Pour the milk into an ice cube tray and freeze until solid.


- Pour your Super-Yummy Peachy Freezy and serve right away

"golden lion tamarin"


