





#### THE BIBLE

In the Old Testament, Jesus wasn't born yet, but God was still just as real!






ave you ever wondered what the difference is between a crocodile and an alligator? Sometimes it can be hard to tell, but nearly all crocodiles have a pointed head and snout, with their teeth sticking out when their mouths are closed. Alligators on the other hand have a more flattened head and snout, and most of their teeth are hidden when their mouths are closed.

One of the main differences is the size. Alligators usually only get 15 feet long, but crocs can get 20 feet in length.

Nearly all alligators live in fresh water in the Americas. Crocodiles live in both fresh and salt-water. The salt-water crocs are the largest reptiles left on earth, and the most aggressive of all crocodilians (alligators and crocodiles combined). We don't know what type of gator was after baby Moses, but we know what happened! God sent His angels to watch over him, because God was going to use him to deliver His people, the children of Israel.
