Here are two words that you might not know: INFLUENCE AND CONTAGIOUS

Both can be either good or bad things.

"Influence" is when something that someone does or says, affects another person. Try this, go give your mom or dad a huge hug and tell them that you love them. Watch the way they change. Your behavior "influenced" them. Wow, positive influence is pretty powerful!

That was an example of being a good influence. You changed everyone's mood by being kind and loving to your parent. But what about places that aren't kind or loving? They have an influence also, and even if you don't like it, they influence you too. Let's say you go somewhere that has worldly music playing in the background; maybe it's the grocery store. Even though you don't like that music, it is still trying to influence you. If you don't do something to keep it out of your mind, that bad music will have an influence on you.

Influence is something that is very important to think about. Are you influencing others in a good way? Make a list of people who you would like to influence, then make a list of people or things that influence you, either good or bad.

"Contagious" is a word that doctors and nurses use a lot. It means that you have something that you could spread to others, like chickenpox. Have you ever gotten sick from someone else? They were contagious when you were around them, and you got what they had.

Your attitude is contagious. If everyone in a room is bored and grumpy, and you come in upbeat and happy, it won't be long before either they are happy with you, or you are grumpy with them. You will either catch what they have, or they will get what you have.

Your spirit is contagious, and so are the spirits of other people. If you spend time with Holy Spirit-filled family and friends, they will rub off on you, and influence you in a good way. But remember, worldly people are contagious too, so you need to do everything you can to protect yourself from the sickness that the world carries.

If you bring the Holy Spirit with you wherever you go, you will influence people in a good way, because you are contagious. Others will get what you have. If you want more of the Holy Spirit, you should hang out with those kids who are contagious with It. You will certainly get more of It from them, and they will get more of It from you.





INGREDIENTS:

2 cups, milk chocolate chips
1 cup, semi-sweet chocolate chips
1 (14 oz.) can, sweetened condensed milk
Dash of salt
1/2 tsp. peppermint extract
1/4 cup crushed peppermint candy cane

Melt everything together except the peppermint candy cane. Put crushed peppermint candy on wax paper in bottom of a 8×8 square pan. Pour chocolate mixture on top and refrigerate.

INGREDIENTS:

6 apples, 1 (14 ounce) package of individually wrapped caramels (unwrapped), 2 tablespoons milk, chopped nuts (optional).

Butter a baking sheet and place your apples on it. Remove the stem from each apple and press a craft stick into the top.

Place caramels and milk in a microwave-safe bowl, and microwave 2 minutes, stirring once. Allow it to cool a little bit, but not too much.

Roll each apple quickly in caramel sauce until it covers the whole apple. Quickly roll it on a pan of chopped nuts, if you want them.

Bring them in for us to enjoy.





"Huh? What's going on? Ohhh, it was just a dream!" Caroline said to her parents.


"What is it Caroline? Are you OK?" her mom asked.

"Everything is OK, Mommy. Let's just not forget about Jesus today, alright?" Caroline begged.



I A CONTAGIOUS CHRISTIAN



Trim off the bottom of each heart and overlap them on the underside of the popsicle stick.



Glue the overlapped bottoms of the hearts together, then glue them to the craft stick. The two large hearts will be the butterfly's wings.

Cut two 2-inch pieces from a chenille stem and glue them to the back of the popsicle stick. These will be the butterfly's antennae!



Use a marker to draw a face on your butterfly.

Use your imagination on how to decorate the wings. Cut out smaller hearts, use glitter, or whatever else sounds fun.







