




Did you ever stop to wonder what is so special about a lamb? Did you ever think that a lamb ties in with Communion? Well, it does!

All throughout the Bible, from Genesis to Revelation, you find lambs. In the very first Book of the Bible, Abel led his lamb, by spiritual revelation, to the altar for sacrifice. In the very last Book of the Bible, there stood a Lamb that was slain before the foundation of the world. In this edition of *God's Creations*, we are going to take a look at some places that lambs are mentioned and learn a few cool facts about them.

#### **Gideon**

Gideon was chosen by the Lord to deliver the children of Israel out of the hands of the Midianites.

God came down in the form of a man to visit Gideon, and commissioned him to deliver Israel. He had been chosen, but he wanted to be positive before going into battle.

Before this mighty man of valor chose his men, he placed a fleece of wool before the Lord, and asked that dew would only be on the fleece and not the ground, come morning. When Gideon arose the next day, it happened just how he asked, the fleece was wet, but the ground around it was dry.

Gideon had gotten his answer, but again he asked the Lord a second time. This time he asked that the fleece be dry and the ground around be wet from dew. God answered once again, and Gideon moved forward to deliver Israel from the hand of the Midianites.

### Abraham

Abraham was a true servant of God. One day God told him to take his promised son, Isaac, up on top of a mountain to sacrifice him. Abraham didn't know why, but he obeyed what God had told him to do. He had built the altar, built the fire, but Isaac asked, "Where is the sacrifice?" Abraham told him.

"God will provide for Himself a sacrifice." Just as Abraham started to pull the knife down to slay his only son, Brother Branham said an Angel grabbed his hand and stopped him.

Just then, a little ram was found with its horns caught in a vine, blatting. Just like when Brother Branham spoke squirels into existence, a ram came into existence for Abraham's sacrifice.

#### **Bartimaeus**

Brother Branham told us that Blind Bartimaeus had a seeing-eye lamb to lead him around, like people today use dogs to help lead them around. Well, Bartimaeus needed that lamb. He couldn't go without it.

Brother Branham tells a story how Bartimaeus' little girl got sick. The lamb that led him around was all that he had. He told the Lord, "But if You'll let my little girl, who I've never seen, if You'll only let her get well, then I'll give You my lamb for a sacrifice." God healed his little girl, and Bartimaeus gave the Lord his lamb. What would he do? How would he get around?

One cold November day, Bartimaeus heard a noise coming down the street. Someone had told him, "Jesus of Nazareth, He passes by," Bartimaeus began to cry out, "O Jesus, Thou Son of David, have mercy! Have mercy!" God had provided a Lamb for Blind Bartimaeus' eyes and our Lord Jesus Christ healed his eyes.



#### Milltown

Brother Branham one time had a vision of a lamb in darkness. He went after it, going through briers and everything to find it. He kept hearing it say, "Baa". The closer he got, it became a human's voice saying, "Milltown". He kept going, and eventually heard someone calling, "Brother Branham?"

The lamb was a little sick girl named Georgie Carter. She had laid on a bed, sick, for almost 10 years. She heard where a crippled girl had been healed, and she was crying and praying that Brother Branham would visit her. He found her, prayed for her and left. One night after this, Brother Branham was praying in the woods and the Lord told him, "Go by the way of Carter's." He

rose up, went to her house, took her by the hand and said, "As the—the Lord God has said to me, 'In The Name of The Lord Jesus Christ, rise up and be whole," and she was instantly healed!




There they sat and fellowshipped as they broke the bread and drank the wine, having sacred communion with one another.
























Brother Branham told us how important




