The neatest thing about quokkas is that God made them! The same God that made YOU, made the fuzzy little quokka!







Samuel laughed, "Okay dad, that sounds great!"









Q: What is your name?

A: Charlie Branham

Q: So, Brother Branham is your uncle, that means Brother Billy Paul and Brother Joseph are your cousins?

Q: Do you go by any other name than Charlie?

A: Actually, Brother Joseph and Brother Billy Paul call me Chick. It is a nick name they gave me.

Q: What is your wife's name and how did you meet?

A: Sister Linda Branham – We met at Brother Branham's meetings

Q: Can you share any neat stories with us?

A: I was able to help with the Branham Tabernacle's latest expansion. Also, I was at the Branham Tabernacle during the Seven Church Age series. On the last day I witnessed the Pillar Of Fire come down and write the Seven Church Ages on the back wall.

Q: Do you have any neat testimonies or stories of your time with Brother Branham?

A: Yes, I have a TON! My wedding was the only wedding with TWO prophets in it. Brother Brahham was the one that married us, and Brother Joseph was our ring bearer. Our wedding was also the only wedding that Brother Brahham set the date and time for – February 20, 1965 at 2 PM.

Q: Did you get to experience anything else supernatural?

A: Yes, I was in the service when Brother Way was resurrected from the dead.

Sister Lois Branham's great-grandson was able to interview his grandma and ask her a few questions about her experiences with Brother Branham. There are some really neat stories in there that we had never heard before! Don't forget to send us your interview with someone who knew Brother Branham!

Q: What was it like to be around Brother Branham?

A: He was just so ordinary, it was very hard for me to recognize things at that particular time. I was young you know.

Q: Did he have a sense of humor?

A: Yes he did! He joked and we had a lot of fun together. Don't ask why, but he always called me granny!

Q: What was the first service you were in of Brother Branham's?

A: When Brother Billy and I were going together there was a service in Cadle Tabernacle in Indianapolis. He wanted to know if I wanted to go to the service. It was a one day thing. So mother said it was ok for me to go since we were coming back the same day. And that was the first service that I was ever in with Brother Branham.

Q: When traveling with Brother Branham what kinds of things did he talk about?

A: Well I would sit in the backseat of course! And he and Brother Billy would talk about various things, like hunting and fishing. He sort of liked to be down to earth when he was traveling. I never heard him talk a lot about the services and meetings. He could have, but I just don't remember. Most of the talk was just between him and Brother Billy, I just sat in the backseat and listened! Everything he said was very interesting!

Q: What was it like being his daughter-in-law?

A: Just normal I suppose. He acted just like an ordinary person until the Lord started working with him with visions or services, whatever it was. But even with that, he was an ordinary person! I couldn't tell the change between the ordinary person or the Brother that preached and had visions.

Q: What was his favorite food?

A: He just liked ordinary every day country food. Beans, potatoes, just like everybody else, but he usually would have, if there were biscuits, he would take a biscuit, put peanut butter on it and sugar. That was like his desert! I do that all the time!

Q: Could you tell when Brother Branham was having a vision?

A: No I couldn't tell when he was having a vision.

Q: How did Brother Branham go about telling you that you were going to have a baby? Did you ask him to pray for you to have a baby or did he just tell you? Where were you when he told you?

A: This one's a little long! I believe we were in Yakima Washington, we traveled several places so I'm really not sure but I believe it was Yakima. But the sign on his hand happened to appear in that service with a sister, you know, and I never understood how it worked! So me and Billy got in the car and then he got in. I questioned him how did the hand work?! And he said, "it would be like if I took your hand, and if there was anything wrong with you..." he stopped talking because his palm swelled up, got red and got white dots on it! He moved his hand away and there was nothing there. When he moved his hand back to mine the same thing happened again! He said, "Sis, he called me Sis a lot, you've got female trouble, that's why you can't have a baby." And he prayed for me there in the car, and nine months later your papa was born!


