












YOU, Cub, & Monkey


What You Need:


- 1 (8 ounce) package elbow macaroni
- 1 (8 ounce) package shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 1 (12 ounce) container small curd cottage cheese
- 1 (8 ounce) container sour cream
- 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- salt and pepper (to taste)
- 1 cup of bread crumbs




What You Need To Do:

- Preheat your oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- Boil a large pot of slightly salted water.
- Add pasta, and cook until done: drain.
- In 9x13 inch baking dish, stir together macaroni, shredded cheddar cheese, cottage cheese, sour cream, parmesan cheese, salt and pepper.
- In a small bowl, mix together bread crumbs and melted butter. Sprinkle topping over macaroni mixture.
- Bake 30 to 35 minutes, or until top is golden brown.

It's so peaceful to live in God's beautiful creation. I knew Brother Branham came out here to rest from his great ministry. But even out here, God was with His prophet.


ne beautiful morning, Brother Branham was fishing with his friends, Brothers Banks and Lyle Wood, at the lake where I live. It was so nice to see them

The I saw something delicious fall into the water. I swam really fast and grabbed it up before my friends could.




For almost 30 minutes I was just lying there on top of the water, dead. But then something miraculous happened!




