




Dear Christian Friends,



ELIJAH

the prophet



About 900 years before Jesus was born, a lot of people worshipped a false god called Baal. God didn't like His people worshipping this false god, so He sent them a true prophet, a prophet named Elijah.

Elijah was a tough man who stood firm on the Word of God. One day Elijah challenged the people. He said, if the Lord is God then you should follow Him, but if Baal is God then follow Baal. Elijah wanted to show that Baal was a false god and that the people who followed him were doing wrong.

Elijah told the prophets of Baal to prepare a sacrifice. He challenged them by saying that if Baal would set their sacrifice on fire, then Baal was a true God. But Elijah knew better. He knew that Baal was not the true God.

The prophets of Baal accepted Elijah's challenge and called on Baal to answer their prayers. They prayed and jumped around, but Baal didn't answer. After a while Elijah told them that their god might

be sleeping, and they should yell a little louder to wake him up. The prophets of Baal yelled even louder than before, but no fire came.

Then it was Elijah's turn. He laid out 12 stones, one for each tribe of Israel, and then dug a trench all the way around the altar. Before he started to pray, he did one more thing. He filled four barrels full of water and poured them onto the wood. The wood was so wet that it looked like it would never burn. Do you know what Elijah did next? He poured four more barrels of water onto the wood. How could the wood ever burn now?

The prophets of Baal must have thought that Elijah was completely crazy. But Elijah had to do one more thing before he prayed for God to light his sacrifice on fire. He poured the barrels of water on the wood for the third time. There was so much water that it filled up the trench that Elijah dug around the wood.

Elijah didn't care how wet the wood was. He knew that God would answer his prayer, and now it was time to show those prophets of Baal who the One true God really was. Elijah prayed and the fire came. The fire burned so hot that it burned up all the wood, the stones, the water, and even the dust around it.

When the people saw what had happened, they knew that Elijah's God was the One true God. They fell on their faces and worshipped!

- Ravens brought Elijah food when he was hungry?


- Elijah never died. He was carried into Heaven!

the Little Finnish Girl




We don't know much about this little girl from Finland, but what we do know is quite incredible.


CAN YOU SEE GOD?







God's CREATIONS



BROTHER BRANHAM SAID:

"Now, that's the famous bear. There's four in the Grizzly family. One is the Silver-Tip, which is the famous. Next is called, the native name, Kadish, which is a black with a round ear; the second. Third is the regular Grizzly, which is between Black and Brown, a huge bear. And the next is the Kodiak, which is only found on Kodiak Island and--and western Alaska; he's great, mammoth, biggest of all bears, but he's a Grizzly. But the Silver-Tip is black, and the white is on--the silver is on the end of the tip of the hair. He's the famous one, very high-strung, ill-tempered bear" - 61-1001M



BEARS

There are eight types of bears in the world; the American Black Bear, Brown Bear, Polar Bear, Giant Panda, Asiatic Black Bear, Sloth Bear, Spectacled Bear, and the Sun Bear. Can you memorize them?

Some bears, like the Polar Bear, are excellent swimmers while other bears, like the Sun Bear, are expert climbers. Most bears will eat almost anything they can get their paws on, but the Giant Panda rarely eats anything other than bamboo. How boring!

Brother Branham speaks a lot about the Grizzly Bear. One type of Grizzly Bear is the Kodiak. Large male Kodiak bears can stand on their back legs and reach 10 feet or higher. That means they could touch a basketball hoop without even jumping. Some of them weigh more than a race car!

While Kodiak bears aren't quite as fast as a race car, they can sprint up to 35 mph for short distances. You better hope that you never get chased by one, because the fastest human sprinters in the world can only reach about 27 mph.





GIANTS

The largest Kodiak Grizzly bear ever recorded weighed over 2,500 pounds and stood almost 14 feet tall. It takes a lot of eating to get to be that size!



THEY EAT WHAT?

They may look like fierce hunters, but most bears mainly eat berries, plants, rodents, and nuts. It's hard to believe they get that big on a few little berries!

BIG APPETITE

Pandas have a specific diet of leaves, shoots, and stems of bamboo. They spend between 10 and 12 hours eating bamboo every day. An adult Panda Bear can eat about 30 pounds of bamboo a day. That's like eating over 100 quarter-pounders from McDonalds every day!



TINY

The Sun Bear lives in India. It is the smallest of all bears, with adult males weighing around 100lbs. They like to eat grubs and honey all night long, and sleep all day.



UP A TREE

When a big male bear comes around a momma bear and her cubs, the cubs usually climb up a tree for safety. But this looks more like a tree climbing party for all the neighborhood bear cubs.



POLAR VS KODIAK

Have you ever heard that the Polar Bear is the largest bear in the world? Brother Branham said the Kodiak Bear is the biggest of all bears. (61-1001M)

According to "The Great Bear Almanac," the average adult male Polar Bear weighs 900 - 1500 pounds, and the average adult Brown Bear weighs 500 - 900 pounds. This scientific information would make it seem like the Polar Bear is bigger, but there is more to the story.


The heaviest Polar Bear ever recorded weighed 2,210 pounds. There have been many Kodiak Brown Bears that weighed well over 2,500 pounds! It is claimed that Polar Bears can only grow to about 8 1/2 feet tall, but Kodiak Brown Bears can grow to 10 ft or more.

So the next time you hear someone say that the Polar Bear is the largest bear in the world, you can say that even science proves that Brother Branham is right. The largest bear in the world is the Kodiak Brown Bear, just like Brother Branham said!

HOW TO...

make icy Bananas

1. Peel the bananas and remove any stringy fibers. Cut the bananas in half and push a popsicle stick through the cut end of each half. Cover them in plastic wrap and freeze for about three hours.
