SUPPLIES

\*"Nazarite Vow" vinyl stencil, \*white canvas 5x7, acrylic paint: white (2 oz), 4 colors of your choice (2 oz total), paintbrush, pick tool (needle or toothpick), disposable plate (to catch excess paint), disposable ramekins (one for each color of paint), cup of water, hair dryer

\*INCLUDED IN SUITCASE

TIP Use hair dryer to dry paint completely between steps.




# Step 2:

Remove the paper backing from your "Nazarite Vow stencil" and place it on the canvas, sticky side down. Smooth over it with your scraper, then gently peel up the transfer tape. Be careful not to pull up any small vinyl pieces that are part of the design.



# Step 5:

Pour your paint colors into ramekins, one color per ramekin. Add water to your paint, a little at a time, until the paint reaches an easy to pour/cake batter consistency.

STEP 1:

Paint your canvas with white paint. You will need 3-4 coats. This will give you a smooth surface so the letters in the quote will not bleed when you paint them. The paint <u>must</u> be completely dry before continuing with next step.



You will need your pick tool (a toothpick or needle works too) to remove the vinyl from the letter centers.

### Step 6:

Pour a layer of white paint into a ramekin. Pour your first color on top. Pour another layer of white paint on top. Pour your second color on top of that. Continue to pour your colors with a layer of white in between them until you have all of your paint included.

### Step 7:

Hold your canvas over your disposable plate. Pour the paint mixture onto your canvas. Tilt the canvas from side to side and tap it to help the paint spread. When you have covered as much canvas as you want to cover lay the canvas down and let it dry.
