

Still Waters Packing Checklist

WHAT TO BRING

- Bible
- Quiet Time Journal with pen or pencil
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, and shower soap are provided)
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Insect repellent
- Hair towel (microfiber or quick-dry towels recommended - we provide bath towels and washcloths)
- Musical instruments
- Cash for vending machines and gift shop
- Snacks (no peanut products)
- Your personal pillow, blanket, or sleeping bag (we supply a pillow and a blanket)
- 4-6 ankle-length denim skirts for daytime activities
- 4-6 tops for daytime activities
- 3 outfits for bonfires
- Two nice outfits for worship services (See FAQ - "How Should We Dress")
- 2-3 extra outfits for YF sponsored weekend activities. Still Waters dress code applies to these events.
- Light jacket for cool mornings and evenings
- Rain jacket
- Sneakers (shoes to "play" in) Closed-toe shoes are required to drive go karts
- Shoes for church services
- Swimsuit (See FAQ - "How Should We Dress")
- Beach towel (microfiber or quick-dry towels recommended)
- Water shoes for the beach
- Flip-flops for the shower
- Sharpies for signing shirts

Tips:

- ▶ Bring a few extra tops and skirts, just in case you fall off the jet ski!
- ▶ Please plan to only hang your dress clothes. There's really not room to hang all your clothing.
- ▶ Clothes steamers are available. Ask your chaperone.

- ▶ It's best to not bring expensive clothing or other expensive items.
