

Building your Seven Church Ages Study Binder

Supplies used:

The supplies below are suggestions. Feel free to be creative and decorate your binder however, and with whatever, you'd like.

- Printables – Cut out each piece.
- 2 sheets of Black Cardstock
- White Cardstock or Printer Paper for printing
- 1 sheet Light Gray Cardstock
- 1 sheet Dark Gray Cardstock
- 1 sheet Gold Cardstock
- Scissors
- X-ACTO knife
- 3-Hole Punch
- Paper Cutter
- Glue
- Glue Stick or Double-Sided Tape
- Craft Brad
- Ruler
- Journaling supplies: Pens, Colored Pencils, Fine-Tip Markers, Chalk Markers, Crayons, Highlighters, or Paint Markers

Set up your pages:

Feel free to arrange your pages however you would like; but if you would like to copy our arrangement, refer to the steps below and to the pictures posted on the Creations website.

- If using a standard view binder, trim excess white around the edges of the cover page and place in the front binder sleeve.
- 3-hole punch 2 pieces of black cardstock and place in your binder. You will use the front and back of the first page.

Paste to page 1:

- The large R and the round Quote. Use an X-ACTO knife or scissors to poke a hole in the top center and use a craft brad to connect the pieces together.
- The rectangle Special Class piece.



Paste to page 2:

- BT Letter and Red Letter Weeks.
 - Make a tri-fold page by cutting a 6" x 11" rectangle out of light gray cardstock. Fold the top side down 3 3/4" and the bottom side up 2 3/4".
 - Paste the letter inside and the Red Letter Weeks on the front fold.
- Book Form and Bro. Branham picture.
 - Cut a 7" x 11" rectangle out of dark grey cardstock and fold in half.
 - Paste the Book Form quote to the inside and the Bro. Branham Study picture to the front.

Paste to page 3:

- The Hebrew 13:8 title and verse, Christ at 33, and Pillar of Fire.
- Place a small piece of washi tape at the top of the verse.
