# Pyramid Tutorial

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

**8 pieces of 7" by 7" by 3/4" assorted types of wood**  
**wood glue**  
**bandsaw**  
**clamps**  
**measuring tape**  
**sand paper**  
**safety glasses**

\*Parental assistance recommended.



**Glue each piece of wood together to make a solid block of eight layers.**

**1.**




**2.**

**Tightly clamp the block together.**



**Let the glue completely dry.**

**Set bandsaw to a 31 degree angle. We recommend making a jig to make this cut safer.**


**5.**

**Cut all four sides of the block.**



**Sand the blade marks on the sides of the pyramid until smooth.**

**Optional:**  
Handwrite  
the lettering  
of the  
stature  
of a perfect  
man on each  
layer of the pyramid,  
starting at the bottom.



**Optional:**  
You can also  
handwrite the seven  
church ages and  
messengers on the  
other sides.

**Apply the finish.  
(We used mineral oil.)**
