# At Creations Class

We started the class by coming together and singing a song unto the Lord, "We Are Together Again." After all were filed in and settled, we invited the presence of our God with a Word of prayer. Remember, Jesus always comes when He is invited, and He keeps all His appointments!

Our young brothers and sisters were eager to get started. First, the students applied the stencils to their mugs and began painting. Then they were instructed to carefully remove the stencils after the paint had dried. Again, we settled and asked for the Holy Ghost to quicken the Word we would hear unto our hearts, and thanked our God for the fun we had already enjoyed. A verse was read from the Bible and a quote was played from our prophet. The students were asked to listen carefully to Brother Branham's instructions on how to make every day a Mother's Day. 
