# BANDSAW BOX TUTORIAL

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

**assorted wood**  
**wood glue**  
**finish (ex: mineral oil)**

## TOOLS NEEDED:

**safety glasses**  
**clamps**  
**measuring tape**  
**pencil**  
**sand paper**  
**bandsaw**  
**router**  
**pin nail gun (optional)**

## CUT LIST:

**7 pieces 7" long x 4 1/2" wide x 5/8" thick**

\*Parental assistance recommended for students under 16.



**1.**  
Glue and clamp all 7 pieces of wood together.



**2.**  
Let the glue dry and then scrape off the excess.



**3.**  
Draw the design of your drawer on the face of the box.



**4.**  
Cut out the design using a bandsaw. (The middle piece will be your drawer.)




**5.**  
Glue and clamp the slit back together where the cutting started.



**6.**  
Mark  $1/2$ " in on both sides of the drawer piece.

Cut a 1/2" off both sides of the drawer piece with the bandsaw. Be sure to mark the front and back of the drawer pieces.



7.

Draw the design of the drawer on the drawer piece.



8.

9.



Cut out the design of the drawer using a bandsaw.

Glue and clamp the front and back of the drawer back onto the drawer.



10.

11. Sand everything.



12.

Make a handle. Use your creativity!





13.

Glue the handle to the front of the drawer.



14.

Do a final sanding.



15.

Apply a finish.
