

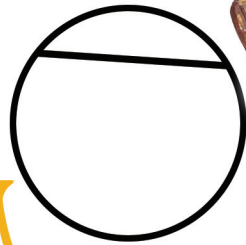

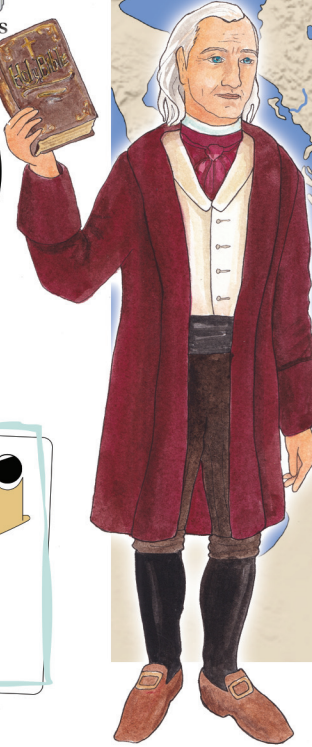

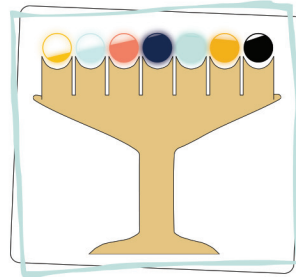

- John Wesley was born June 17, 1703 in Epworth, England
- He was the 15th of 19 children
- He woke up at 4AM to begin preaching at 5AM practically every day of his ministry
- Wesley rode 4,500 miles per year, by horse, to carry the Gospel
- He preached up to 4 times a day, that is more than 40,000 sermons in his ministry
