

Holy Week JOURNEY

Follow along each day on the Creations website to read Scriptures and hear what Brother Branham says about each of these days.



SUPPLIES:

Most of the items below can be found cheapest at your local craft or dollar store, but we have included links for your convenience, along with how many projects you can get from each pack ordered. Feel free to recreate with whatever supplies are available to you.

- 15oz. **Air-Dry Clay**- 5 projects per pack
- 12"x12" **Adhesive Cork Sheet**- 12 projects per pack
- 6"x16" **Brown Kraft Paper Bag**- 25 projects per pack
- 4 8" rectangles **Floral Foam**- 2 projects per pack
- **Small Wooden Tables**- or Table Printable
- **Moss**- small pinch
- 19 10"-12' **Wood Kebab Skewers**- 5 projects per pack
- 11"x18' **Burlap**- 6 projects per roll (optional for backdrop)
- **Brown Rocks**
- **Gray Rocks**
- **Brown Sand**
- Larger Earth-Tone Rocks
- Hot Glue Gun
- Elmer's Glue
- Cardstock - 5 sheets- for printables
- Scissors
- Acrylic Paints - Browns and Tans for Tomb; Gold for Coins
- Paintbrush
- Water Cup
- Clay Tools



PREPARATION & TIPS

Follow along with the journey by adding more to your project each day of Holy Week.
Use the printables for each day, attaching them with glue and skewers.
He is risen!

Making the diorama base:

- Measure 6" up the bottom of the kraft paper bag and cut.
- Stuff the floral foam blocks into the bottom of the kraft paper bag. Trim down floral foam if it goes above the bag.
- Cut and stick your cork to the base. Use your remaining scrap piece of bag crumpled and place on the right side of base.
- Then add 7oz of clay rolled out and painted to the top to form a little mountain. (view tips below)
- Make path with rocks & sand.
- Optional: Use burlap and skewers to make a backdrop.



Now you're ready to start your **HOLY WEEK** journey!

Clay:



Air dry clay will take overnight to fully harden, but should be dry enough to paint within a couple hours.

Sunday: Use 7oz of clay to make your mountain base, let dry and paint.

Monday: Use a small amount of clay to make small coins. Let them dry and paint them gold.

Friday: Work your clay into shape of the tomb and the stone. Use your clay tools to mark the stone lines. Let the pieces dry, then glue on the moss.

Sunday Placement Tips:

Paste the Sunday Calvary onto the back of the Friday Calvary on your diorama. Repeat for your "For He is Risen as He said" banner to the back of the Friday "That Day On Calvary" banner.

Then turn your crosses around from cloudy to the sunrise, and roll the stone away from the tomb.
