Moral:

Always display the Token.

Scriptures:

Joshua 2:2-6

- 2 And it was told the king of Jericho, saying, Behold, there came men in hither to night of the children of Israel to search out the country.
- 3 And the king of Jericho sent unto Rahab, saying, Bring forth the men that are come to thee, which are entered into thine house: for they be come to search out all the country.
- 4 And the woman took the two men, and hid them, and said thus, There came men unto me, but I wist not whence they were:
- 5 And it came to pass about the time of shutting of the gate, when it was dark, that the men went out: whither the men went I wot not: pursue after them quickly; for ye shall overtake them.
- 6 But she had brought them up to the roof of the house, and hid them with the stalks of flax, which she had laid in order upon the roof.



Joshua 2:12-21

- 12 Now therefore, I pray you, swear unto me by the LORD, since I have shewed you kindness, that ye will also shew kindness unto my father's house, and give me a true token:
- 13 And that ye will save alive my father, and my mother, and my brethren, and my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death.
- 14 And the men answered her, Our life for yours, if ye utter not this our business. And it shall be, when the LORD hath given us the land, that we will deal kindly and truly with thee.
- 15 Then she let them down by a cord through the window: for her house was upon the town wall, and she dwelt upon the wall.
- 16 And she said unto them, Get you to the mountain, lest the pursuers meet you; and hide yourselves there three days, until the pursuers be returned: and afterward may ye go your way.
- 17 And the men said unto her, We will be blameless of this thine oath which thou hast made us swear.
- 18 Behold, when we come into the land, thou shalt bind this line of scarlet thread in the window which thou didst let us down by: and thou shalt bring thy father, and thy mother, and thy brethren, and all thy father's household, home unto thee.
- 19 And it shall be, that whosoever shall go out of the doors of thy house into the street, his blood shall be upon his head, and we will be guiltless: and whosoever shall be with thee in the house, his blood shall be on our head, if any hand be upon him.
- 20 And if thou utter this our business, then we will be quit of thine oath which thou hast made us to swear.
- 21 And she said, According unto your words, so be it. And she sent them away, and they departed: and she bound the scarlet line in the window.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Your choice of Wood
- Wood glue
- 3/8" pin nails
- Finish (we used mineral oil or lacquer)
- Red felt
- 3/4" nails or tack nails
- Cassette Tape

TOOLS NEEDED:


- Bandsaw
- Measuring tape
- Sand paper
- Safety glasses
- Pin nail gun
- Table saw
- Mitre saw




STEPS:

- 1. Cut four 7 1/2" x 1 1/2" x 1/4" slats for the front of the house
- 2. Cut two 6" x 3/4" x 1/4" slats for your back supports
- 3. Cut two 8" x 1" x 1/4" slats for your roof
- 4. Cut a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" x 1/8" piece of wood for your door
- 5. Cut a 5" tall triangle using a 35-degree angle on the mitre saw
- 6. Cut one front slat to a 35-degree angle on each top corner
- 7. Glue and nail the back supports to the front slats so that there is an equal space between each slat with the angled slat on the top. Make sure to have about 1/4" space from the top of back slat to top of front slat, so there is room for attaching the gable.
- 8. Cut a 55-degree angle on one end of both roof slats
- 9. Glue and nail the roof slats together so that the 55-degree angles are together
- 10. Glue and nail the gable on the back of the lower portion of the house
- 11. Glue and nail roof to gable
- 12. Glue and nail door
- 13. Mark where the nails to hold tape in place go
- 14. Hammer in nails for the tape
- 15. Sand
- 16. Apply finish
- 17. Glue on scarlet thread
- 18. Place tape on nails
- 19. Place lettering on
- 20. You're Finished


