The Seven Seals: See “Classroom Setup” on page 5 before teaching.

- How many of you are familiar with the ‘Seven Seals’ series Brother Branham preached on tape?
- He started the series Sunday, March 17, 1963, preached all week long, and ended the series on Sunday, March 24, 1963. (Could use Red Letter Calendar to point out dates.)
- Brother Branham preached another series, The Seven Church Ages, in December of 1960. Although, these two series are different, they go right along with each other and dovetail perfectly.
- Brother Branham even preached a whole sermon titled, “The Breach Between The Seven Church Ages And The Seven Seals” 63-0317.
- Breach means a gap or a tie. In this sermon, he bridges the gap between these two great series and ties them together.
- Something else the Seven Church Ages and Seven Seals have in common is they needed a certain angel messenger to reveal the many truths and mysteries hidden in them.
- Let’s start by getting more of a background on the Seven Seals. We find the Seven-Sealed mysteries and the Church Ages are written in the same book of the Bible. Do you know where? In the Book of Revelation. (Hold up Bible opened to Revelation) The very last book of the Bible. The devil hates this book, doesn’t he? Yes, he does!
- Even though these two series are written in the Bible, they were written in a mysterious way, so we were not able to understand what they meant.
- You can read about the First through Sixth Seals in Revelation 6, and the Seventh Seal in Revelation 8:1.
- How many seals are there? Seven. (Younger classes may count 1-2-3...)
- Yes, there were seven great mysteries or secrets sealed away, that NO ONE knew, except God!
- Once these seven mysteries or secrets were revealed, they were to open up the entire Bible to us! They were God’s redemptive plan.
- Does anyone remember who the scribe was for the Book of Revelation? Yes, John the Revelator. He was commanded to write what he saw.
- He saw many visions while he was on the Isle of Patmos. He saw hidden things which were to be kept secret, including the Seven Seals! John was told to seal them up. All these things were to be hidden until the end time, the time we are living in right now! The Laodicean Church Age.
- Let’s read about something special John saw. Turn to Revelation 5:1.

#### Revelation 5:1

1 And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

- What did John see? Yes, a book with writing on the inside and sealed on the backside, or the outside, with 7 seals!
- It wasn’t like the books we have today (Hold up a Bible.)
- They used scrolls during that time. They looked similar to this. (Hold up 7 sealed scroll, pointing out the seven seals.)
- Let’s listen to Brother Branham describe this... (During Quote 1 use two unrolled pieces of paper, and a finished seven sealed scroll to act out what Brother Branham is saying.)

#### Play Quote 1:

It seemed like there was some things, especially in these Seals, because those Seals are the entire Book. See? It’s the Book. The whole Book is one Book, sealed. It starts...

6 For instance, if I had something here, I’d show you what I mean. [Brother Branham illustrates the rolling and sealing of a scroll, by using sheets of paper—Ed.] Here is one seal. That’s one, and you roll it up like this, the way it was rolled. And you roll it up in this manner. And, at the end, there is a little piece sticking out, like that. That’s the first seal. All right, then, that’s the first part of the book. Then, the next seal is rolled in this manner, right by the side of it. And it’s rolled up in this manner, like here. And then, at the end, right here, there is another sticking out. Means, two seals.

7 And that’s the way the whole Bible was wrote, in scrolls. [Brother Branham unrolls the sheets of paper that he was using for illustration—Ed.] And, so, the...to break these Seals, it opens the mysteries of the Book.

- How neat to have Brother Branham describe that for us!
- Let's keep reading in Revelation to see what happened after John saw this Seven-Sealed Book.

### Finish reading Revelation 5:2-7

(Younger classes may want to sum this up instead of reading all of the verses.)

2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?

3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

4 And I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look thereon.

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

- What happened? Yes, an angel with a loud voice asked the question, "Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?"
- Was there any man worthy to open the Book and to loose the seals that were on It? No, no man was worthy! Not in Heaven, in the earth, or under the earth was there a man worthy to open this book or to read it.
- Now remember, this was the Book of God's redemptive plan. It was very important! If it couldn't be opened and read we wouldn't know what was inside the Book.
- When John saw this he was very upset (sad), and he began to weep much!
- Then, he heard one of the elders tell him not to weep, there is one that is worthy.
- Who did John see? A Lamb that had been slain. Who is that Lamb? Jesus! Let's hear what the Lamb, Jesus, did after he took that Book and loosed those seven seals...

### Play Quote 2:

301 But the first thing, that represented that redemption, come the Lamb that had been slain from the foundation of the world. And He took the Book, (glory!) opened the Book, and tore off the Seals; and sent It down to the earth, to His seventh angel, to reveal It to His people! [Congregation greatly rejoices—Ed.] There you are. Oh, my! What happened? The screams, the shouts, the hallelujahs, the anointed, the power, the glory, the manifestation!

### 63-0317e - "The Breach Between The Seven Church Ages And The Seven Seals"

- How are we supposed to know what those hidden things are? If they are secret, who can tell us? Who does the Word of the Lord come to? Right, the Prophet! Remember Amos 3:7? (Recite verse as a class.)
- Not just any prophet! The Seals and these hidden things are different. It took a certain prophet to reveal them! Who did Brother Branham just say Jesus sent them down to? The seventh angel! Who is the seventh angel messenger? Right, Brother Branham!
- Just before Brother Branham preached the Seven Seals series, many supernatural and mysterious things happened. (Refer to "The Events Leading Up To The Seven Seals" Worksheet on board) Brother Branham had went out West to Arizona after a vision had come to pass and sent him there.
- In January 1963, while praying in Sabino Canyon, a beautiful Sword appeared in Brother Branham's hand, and a Voice shook down through the canyon and said, "It's the Sword of The King". Brother Branham said The King was God and the Sword was the Word. (63-0324E) (Point to "The Sword Of The King" picture.)

(Flannel Board- Cloud Scene)

- Next, another truly remarkable Supernatural event happened! While he was hunting at Sunset Mountain on February 28, 1963, seven angels came down, blasted the earth and said, "Return back to Jeffersonville, from where you come from, for the Seven Seals of the seven mysteries will be opened." (65-0219)
- The seven angels formed a cloud visible in the sky all day long. It was photographed, and the pictures were even published in Life magazine. It was 26 miles high and 30 miles across.
- After this happened, Brother Branham returned to Jeffersonville, Indiana, to begin preaching the Seven Seals on March 17th, 1963.
- We know and believe by revelation, Brother Branham is the seventh angel messenger. Where in the Bible can we find the Scripture mentioning the seventh angel and the mystery of God? Revelation 10:7. (Recite verse as a class.)
- Let's turn over in our Bibles to Revelation 10:4-7 and follow along as Brother Branham reads this Scripture and explains it for us.

Play Quote 3:

34 Now, John was commissioned to write what he saw, so the apostle, and prophet, picked up his pen to write It.

And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

35 Now, that's what we don't know. That's yet to be revealed. It's not in Holy Script, what them Thunders say.

And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hands to heaven, (now listen)

And sware by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created the heavens, and the things that there-in are, and the earth, and the things...therein are, and...there should be time no longer:

36 Watch! Here is a verse I want to get to.

But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he has declared to his servants the prophets.

37 Now, see, the mystery of this Seven-Seal Book will be revealed at the sounding of the seventh church angel's Message. See? "The seventh angel begins to sound," and there is the Messages wrote out there, and we got It in tape and book form. Now, "At the beginning of the sounding of the Message, the mystery of God should be finished, see, at that time."

63-0317e - "The Breach Between The Seven Church Ages And The Seven Seals"

- Amen! At the sounding of that seventh angel's Message, the mystery of God should be finished! Like the mysteries of these Seven Seals.
- How do we listen to the voice of Revelation 10:7? Listen to the tapes! That's why we press play everyday! The 'voice' on those tapes is the very Voice of God speaking directly to us!
- God used the seventh angel's voice, Brother Branham's voice, and stored it up for us so we could hear it on the tapes!
- With the tapes, we are still able to hear the mysteries of the Seven Seals Jesus sent down for us, His people!
- We are at the end time, and Jesus will be here very soon!

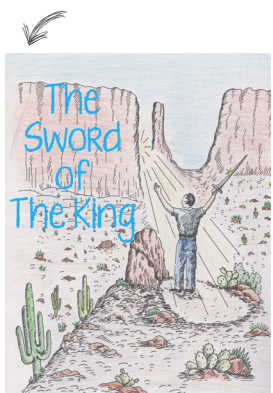

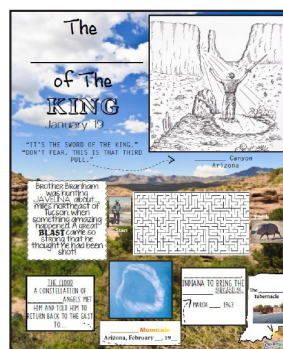

The "Events Leading Up To The Seals"

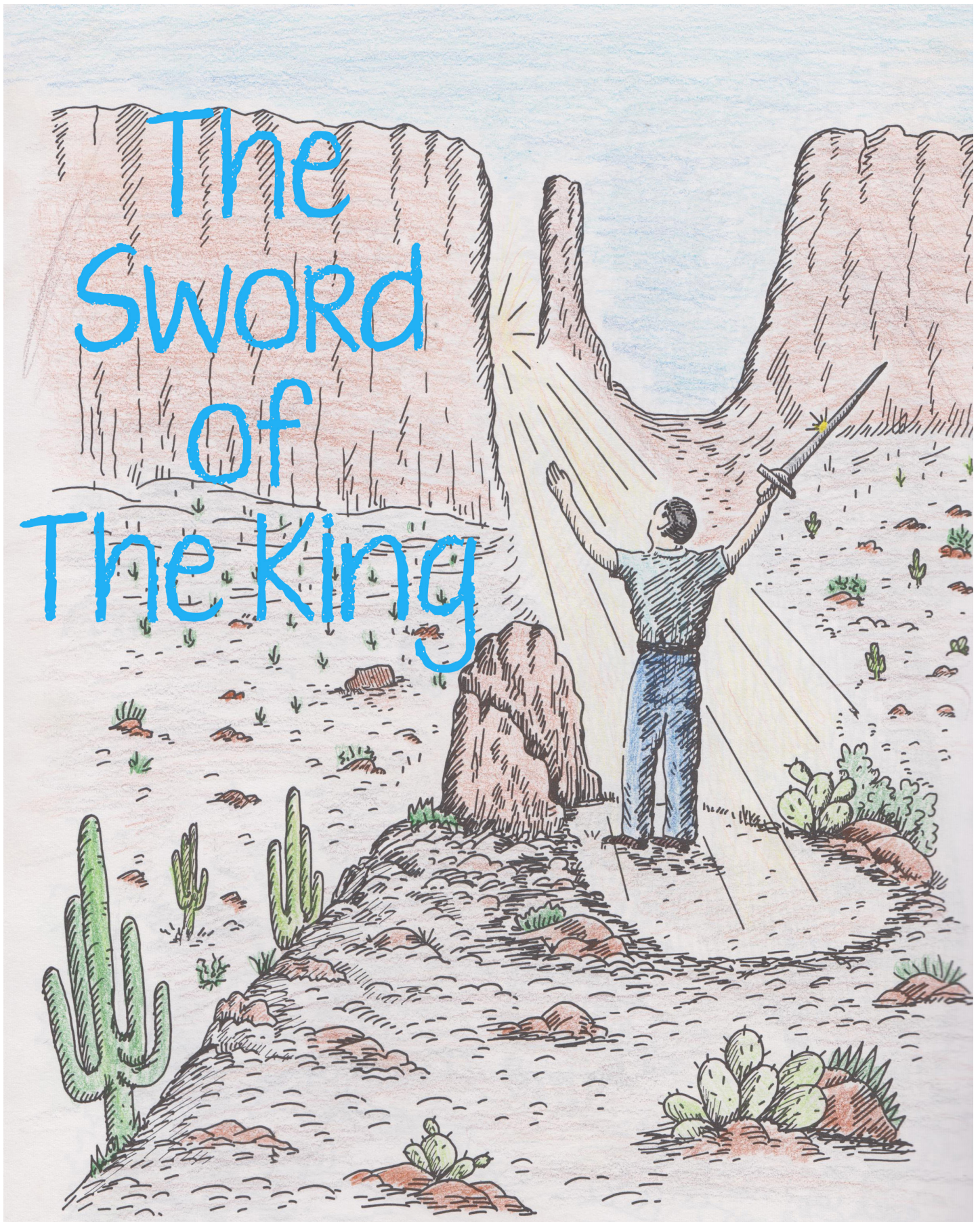

# ...And a High Cloud Ring of Mystery



Heaving like a giant's smoke ring, a great cloud appeared at sunset over Flagstaff, Ariz. last Feb. 26 and set off a continuing scientific mystery. Watchers struck by the cloud's odd shape and huge size, took pictures, like these four, at different times and from widely scattered locations in the state. Dr. James McDonald, a meteorologist at the Institute of Atmospheric Physics in Tucson, has been accumulating the pictures. Using them as the basis for trigonometric calculations, he has made a startling discovery: that the cloud was at least 20 miles high and 20 miles across—"a lot higher and bigger," he says, "than a cloud should be." The cloud was too high to be made by a jet plane, and as far as Dr. McDonald can determine, there were no rockets, rocket planes or bombs being tested nearby that day. He hopes anyone else with pictures will lend them to him, for he would like some more clues about the cloud 20 miles up—no water droplets exist at that height to make a cloud.

## The First Seal

### Revelation 6:1-2

1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.

2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.

## The Second Seal

### Revelation 6:3-4

3 And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.

4 And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.

## The third Seal

### Revelation 6:5-6

5 And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

## The fourth Seal

### Revelation 6:7-8

7 And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.

8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

## The fifth Seal

### Revelation 6:9-11

9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

## The sixth Seal

### Revelation 6:12-17

12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

1 And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour.

<sup>25</sup> Or, this, the Trumpets, they're very, very fine. I looking at it the other day. See, on the Sixth Seal, all Seven Trumpets sounds right there on that Sixth Seal, see, just before the Seventh Seal opens the Coming of Christ.

<sup>26</sup> And, tonight, I have a very important Message that I want to speak just before the—the—the healing service. And if you're here, and are going to stay over, well, we'll try, if it possible to start just a little bit early, 'cause there'll be a prayer line. I won't preach too long, but there is something that I've wanted to say to the church, for some time, and kind of post you on the—the—the—the . . . how things are running at this time, and just where we're standing, and the best of my knowledge through the Scripture.

<sup>27</sup> Now, I want you to turn this morning with me, if you want to mark down or keep record of where we are reading from, the Book of Isaiah. And I wish to read from Isaiah, the 42nd chapter of Isaiah.

<sup>28</sup> We are very happy this morning, also, to have Brother Dauch sitting with us here. While you're turning . . . You know, they thought he wasn't going to live, here in Shreveport the other day. And he's certainly got faith. Yes, sir, he climbs right out of it; the Lord blesses him right on, yeah. See, Brother Dauch is ninety-one years old, and had a complete heart failure; and heart attack, on top of it. And the very doctor said that they didn't see there's any way for him to live. Brother Dauch is living, and the doctor is dead. See?

Then we go to Chicago for the convention, or meeting in Chicago, the last week in this month. And then I have to take the family back to Arizona, for—for their vacation is over and the kiddies has to go back to school.

24 Now, how many enjoyed the reading of the Word, and the blessings of the Lord? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] We all do, so greatly.

25 Now, it's hot, and I know some of you goes back home tonight. I know Brother Rodney and Charlie, and them, has to drive a long ways. And wait a minute, you're on vacation, aren't you? Well, I hear you're going fishing.

"The Lord don't lot time to the man when he's fishing. You don't get any older while you're fishing." So, now, you girls go with them. See? And I'll come down and join you, if I can. And you know, "The good Lord," they said, "don't lot time to a man when he's out fishing." Do lot of it when you—when you feel all twisted up. And went ahead, say, "A man that has . . . Every man, his brothers, out fishing. With a helping hand, they'll always land, out fishing." Had about eight or ten different things. Then when he got down at the bottom, said, "Man is closer to God when he's out fishing." So I think that's about right. "The rich and poor are all the same, out fishing." See? "A helping hand, he'll always land, out fishing." And everything was about, "Out fishing."

27 Well, I'll tell you another fishing I've been doing for about the last thirty-three years, has been fishing for the souls of men. May the Lord help us to win every one that we can find.

28 Now, tonight, this is taping. Now, this morning, (if Jim is here, or taping), I—I think, on the tape, somebody called my attention to it, I said, "The second exodus." I didn't mean *second*. It's, "Third exodus."

The Holy Spirit in the form of a Pillar of Fire, God coming down in manifestation, brought out the first exodus, and—and back in . . . brought Israel out of Egypt.

The second exodus was Christ bringing the Church out of Judaism.



# "The Seven Seals" Tutorial



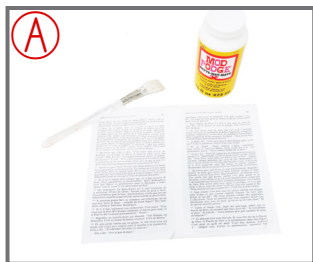
## What you will need:

- 7 "Scroll Print Outs"
- 1 Bible Verse Print Out
- White cardstock (4 pieces, letter size)
- Mod Podge
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- 7 Paper clips
- Twine
- 2 hot glue guns and hot glue
- Red sealing wax (must be usable with a glue gun)
- Seal/Stamp kit (must include numbers 1-7)
- Wax Paper

### Important:

Unless your hot glue gun is brand new, it must be cleaned of all glue residue before you can use it for the sealing wax. You typically need to run an entire wax stick through the gun to clean it, before using for the seals.

Mod Podge the scroll print outs to your cardstock. You can fit two print outs on one sheet of cardstock.



On the other side of the cardstock, Mod Podge one Bible Verse to the back of each scroll print out. This will be the inside of each scroll.

Cut out your scroll pieces while the Mod Podge is still wet. You can trim the pieces for a wavy edge.

③



While the scrolls are still wet from the Mod Podge, roll up the Seventh Seal scroll tightly and use a paper clip to keep it from unrolling. Roll the Sixth Seal scroll around the bottom of the Seventh Seal scroll, and paper clip it closed. Roll the Fifth Seal scroll around the bottom of the Sixth Seal and so on, until you've rolled all seven scrolls to fit together. Now you can let the scrolls dry.

④



While your scrolls are drying, cut seven pieces of twine, each one about 10 inches in length.

⑤



With your sealing wax and stamps (numbers 1-7) ready, squirt a nickel-sized amount of wax onto your wax paper. Press down with the stamp and leave it in place as the wax cools. After about 20-30 seconds you should be able to gently peel the seal away from the stamp.

⑥



Remove the paper clips, and hot glue a piece of twine to the corner of each scroll.

⑦



Place a dot of hot glue above where you glued the twine in step 5. Let the hot glue cool for a few seconds, then place a seal. If the hot glue isn't cooled slightly before you place the seal, it will melt it! Wrap the twine around the scroll and tie it in a knot. Repeat this for all seven seals.
