At Creations Class

"What little boy asked the question, 'Has Jesus got a boat?" Puzzled faces started wondering when the teacher asked this question.

"How do we get answers to our questions?" By pushing play and hearing what our prophet has to say!

Part 1 — Disciples and Jesus sailing

"102 And what a secure feeling it must have been, to those disciples, to know that the very Creator, that had thoroughly identified Himself to be that Person, was sailing with them.

And what a blessed thought it is, what a blessed hope it is, what an assurance it is, in this dark hour at the end of world's history, to know the Creator is sailing life's solemn main with us, safely tucked in! Bombs, whatever may come, let them ride, burst, blow, whatever they want to, it makes no difference to me, I'm sailing with the Creator. What a security, while sailing these waters!"

Part 2 – Trouble sets in

"107 And now, remember, they had all had this in their heart and was thinking of these things. And while sailing around on the sea, how they could be like children, as long as He was in the ship with them.

Now, friend, what that ought to do to us! The same identified Jesus Christ, the same Creator, the same God, is with us tonight. What a secure it--it is, what a feeling, to know that His Presence is here. 109 Now we find, right when they was having this great time, all of a sudden, trouble arose. The ship rocked, the sails blew off, the water filled the boat. All hopes of survival was gone."

"115 Trouble Set in. And they forgot that the very One that they were talking about, the very Creator, was in the boat with them."

Part 3 — "Calling Jesus On The Scene"

"132 After these discip-... disciples found themselves at the end, it must have dawned on some of them that the Creator was still with them.

133 I hope it does that to us, tonight, for Hebrews 13:8 says He's the same.

134 Then what did they do? They awakened Jesus. "Go wake-a Jesus. Wake Him, call Him on the scene!" He is very easy called. They had seen, seen so many things that God had done, and--and the Words a vindicating Him. So have we. And He was not hard to be called into action.

135 They woke Him up, and said, "Do You... carest Thou not that we perish?"

Part 4 – Jesus answers

"149 He was a man, out here in this boat that night, when He was out on the sea, where ten thousand devils of the sea swore they would drown Him. That little old boat tossed about like a bottle stopper out there on the stormy sea. He was a man, tired, sleeping. But when they awakened Him and called Him on the scene, He put one foot upon the brail and looked up, and said, "Peace, be still," and the winds and the waves obeyed Him. That was more than a man. That was God."



PETER

Andrew's Brother. He was very outspoken. He denied Jesus three times, but then got the Holy Spirit and became the spokesman on the day of Pentecost.






JAMES (THE ELDER)

Brother of John (sons of thunder) He was always mentioned with John. He was killed by Herod with the sword (Acts 12:2)

MATTHEW

A tax collector (publican.) He was also known as Levi. Wrote the book of "Matthew"









JUDE (THADDEUS)

The brother of James. He wrote the book of Jude. Known by several names, like "Judas, not Iscariot"

JUDAS ISCARIOT

He was the treasurer and a traitor. He sold Jesus for 30 pieces of silver. Judas hung himself on a sycomore tree after he betrayed Jesus.



JOHN

The brother of James (son of Zebedee) He was young when he was with Jesus, and lived to be an old man, even though they tried to kill him. He wrote the books of John, 1st John, 2nd John, 3rd John and Revelation.

JAMES (THE YOUNGER)

Son of Alphaeus. Brother to Jude.



PHILIP

A fisherman in Bethsaida. (John 1:44) Led to preach to the Ethiopian. (Acts 8)



SIMON (THE ZEALOT)

Zealots were a tough Jewish group that hated Roman rule.



THOMAS (ALSO DIDYMUS)

When Jesus rose, he said he wouldn't believe it until he could place his fingers in the nail prints of Jesus' hands and side.

NATHANAEL


A Jew without guile (John 1:47) "Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree..."


