

Isle of Patmos Study Binder Instructions

Supplies used:

- Printables – Cut out each piece.
- 2 Pieces of Black Cardstock
- White Cardstock (for printing)
- 1 Sheet of Vellum paper
- 1 Sheet of Gold Cardstock
- Adhesive Dots
- Paint Markers – White and Gold
- Scissors
- X-ACTO Knife
- Craft Brad
- Glue/Glue Stick
- Double-Sided Tape

Setup of your pages:

Reminder: Refer to pictures for placement.

- 3-hole punch 2 pieces of black cardstock and add to your binder. Open them to create a 2-page spread (left and right pages).

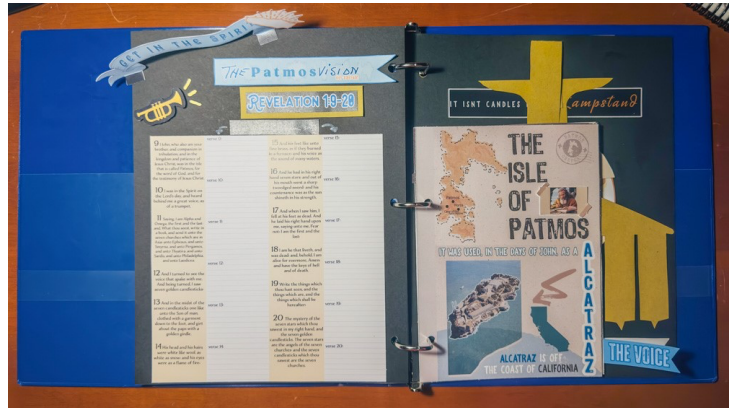
Lesson 1:

Paste on the left page:

- Scripture and notes printable, Patmos Vision title, Scripture Reference, What did Bro Branham Say, and Trumpet.
- What Is The First Thing and Get In The Spirit Banner. *See video in gallery.*
 - Align the black tabs and glue together.
 - Paste the Pillar of Fire to the banner.
 - With the Get in the Spirit side facing you, paste the tabs to the page.

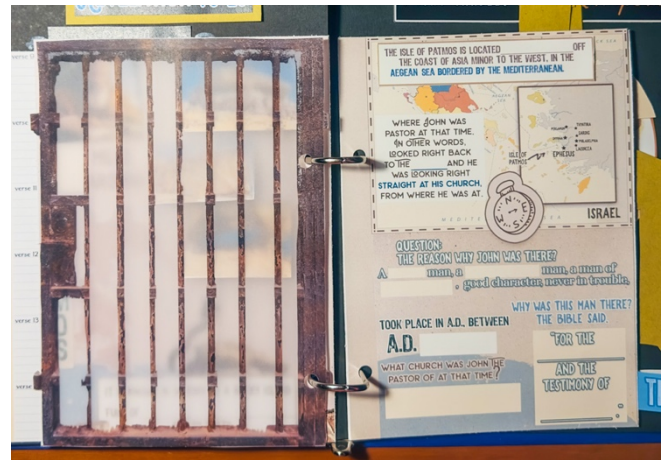
Paste on the right page:

- The Lord's Day, Sabbath, and The Voice. Match the correct description tab to each one and paste inside. Fold on the solid line.
- Lampstand. *See video in gallery*
 - **Before cutting out**, use paint markers to paint the stars gold and the light part of the moons white.
 - Use adhesive dots to attach the square brace piece to the lampstand.
 - Fold long brace piece at fold lines and glue to the bottom of Lampstand.



Isle of Patmos Book:

- Assemble book according to page number, pasting the pages together so it is a double-sided page.
- Hole-punch pages and attach to the bottom two rings in your binder.
- Cut out the vellum prison bars. Hole-punch right side of vellum prison bars and place between pages 3-4.
- Paste printables into the book and fill in the question boxes.



Lesson 2:

Paste on the right page:

- 7-Fold Glory Circle.
 - Using scissors or an X-ACTO knife, poke a hole in the middle of both circles and attach together with a craft brad.
