

## **SHIELD**

**AGE: 10-11**

**ESTIMATED LENGTH: 3 HOURS**

### **NEEDED MATERIALS:**

- Hardwood
- Glue

### **TOOLS NEEDED:**

- Orbital sander
- Table saw
- Miter saw
- Chisel
- Router
- Jigsaw or band saw

### **INTRO AND CLASS SUMMARY:**

- Read scripture and discuss parable.
- Start class with prayer.
- Play and discuss quote used from the Jubilee tape during break.

### **SCRIPTURES: PSALMS 33:20**

*Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.*

### **MORAL PARABLE:**

The Lord is our shield.

### **SHIELD TUTORIAL:**

1. Use ½" thick hardwood.
2. Cut the ½" hardwood into boards.
3. Laminate boards together so that it is 25 ½" wide and 18" long.

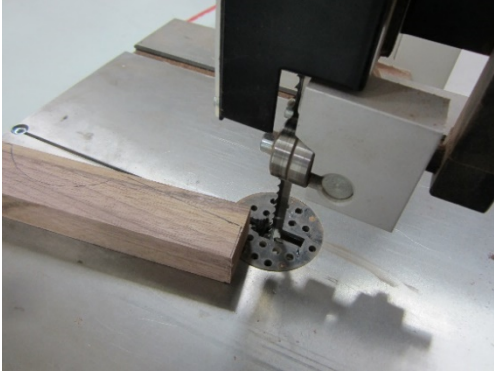


4. Make template of desired shield and trace onto laminated board.



5. Cut out shield on band saw.
6. Sand.

7. Cut a piece of wood 10 ¼" long by 1 ¾" wide by 1" thick.



8. Cut a half circle out of one side so that you can attach your enarnes.



9. Screw the 10 ¼" long by 1 ¾" wide by 1" thick piece of wood to the back of the shield. Be sure to pre drill.



10. Attach 2 pieces of leather for the enarnes.



11. You can place anything you want as your boss or center of your shield.



12. Final sanding

13. Finish with mineral oil.
