1. Gather your supplies.



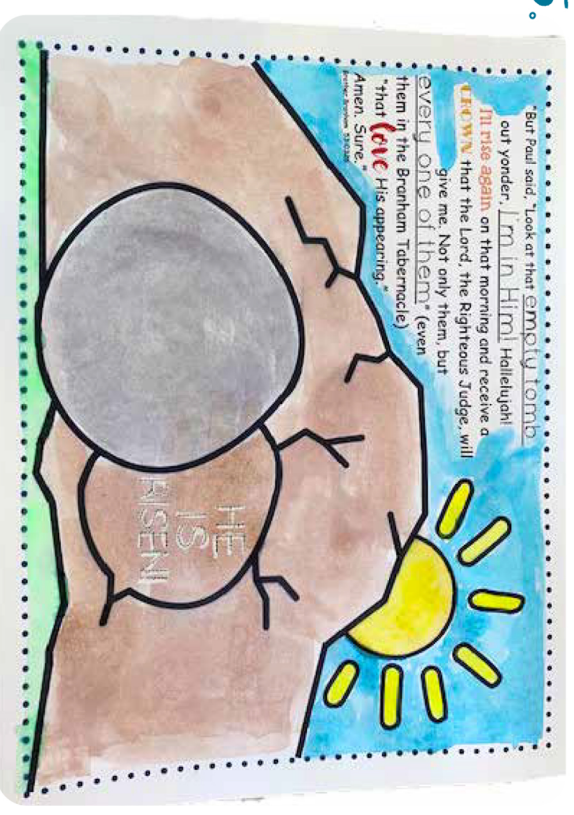
2. Read the quote to your student and, if needed, help them trace over the dotted letters with a pencil.
