
STEP 1

Cut a small rectangle into the bottom of your red cup.




STEP 2

Cut out the quote diagonally.



STEP 3

Glue the quote together.



STEP 4

Glue the quote to the top of the cup.

Hot glue the tea light to the top of the cup with the switch coming out of the hole.



STEP 5

Wrap the quote around the cup and glue the excess underneath.


STEP 6



Your lighthouse should look like this!



STEP 7



Mark an inch up the clear cup and cut around the edge at that mark.

STEP 8

Hot glue the cut edge of the clear cup to the top of the red cup, over the tea light.



Cut a 1 1/2" by 2" piece of black construction paper.



STEP 10

Fold black piece in half over the width and glue as the door to your lighthouse.




STEP 11

STEP 9

Glue and wrap the yarn around where the two cups meet.



Cut (2) 3/4" by 1" pieces of black construction paper.




STEP 12

Glue the windows to your lighthouse.

STEP 14




Cut out the pieces from your roof template.

STEP 15




Cut slits in all the solid lines of this piece.

STEP 16



Bend the loose edges up and down.

STEP 17



Crease all the inside dotted lines.

STEP 18




Glue the two edge wedges on top of each other.


