Pinewood Derby Car Tutorial

Tools Needed

- Bandsaw
- Measuring tape
- Sandpaper
- Safety glasses
- Drill press

Materials Needed

- Assorted wood
- Wood glue
- Pinewood derby wheels and axles
- Finish

*** Parental assistance recommended.

Steps

1. Start with one block of pinewood 7"x 2 1/8"x 1 1/8".



2. Make mark 3/4" from end and 1/8" from the bottom on both sides of the block.

3. With a 5/64 drill bit, drill 3/4" deep at marked points.



4. Draw design on wood.

5. Cut out with bandsaw. *Note* make sure to give plenty of room for axle strength.



6. Sand.

7. Use a nail same size as axles to re-drill axle holes.



8. Place axle through tire into the wood by hand. *Note* axle should be able to be put in with hand but not fall out when racing.

9. Finish with decals of your choice.
