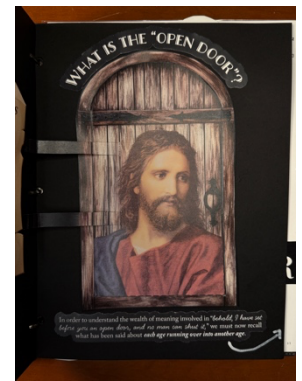
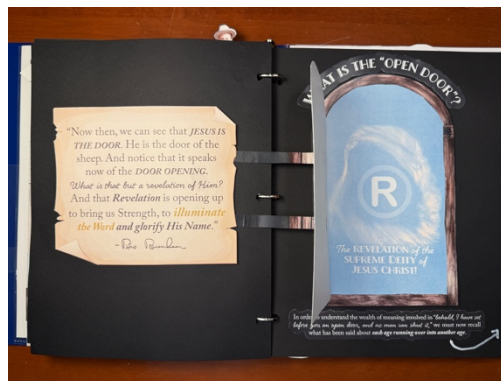
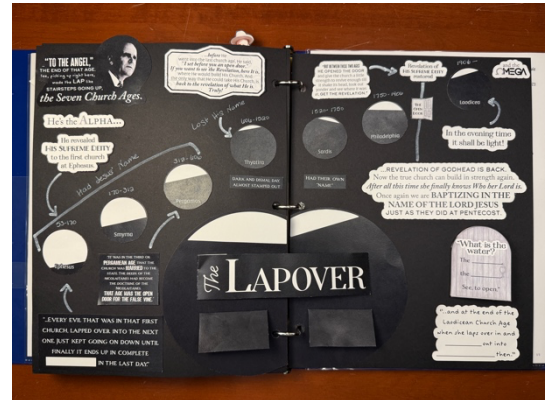


The Lapover

Study Binder Instructions

Supplies used:

- Printables – Cut out each piece.
- 3 Sheets Black Cardstock
- Adhesive Foam Dots (to attach any stickers you'd like)
- Scissors
- X-ACTO Knife
- Glue/Glue Stick
- Double-sided Tape
- White Paint Marker
- White Gel Pen



Set up your pages

Reminder: Refer to pictures and videos for details and placement.

- 3-hole punch 2 pieces of black cardstock and place in your binder.
- These pages will be numbered 1-4. Page 1 will start on the back of the Philadelphia page.

Pages 1 & 2:

Right page:

- Door- see video.
 - Use an X-ACTO knife to cut along dotted lines around door, and two small slits in door.
 - Paste the Revelation printable on page.
 - Paste door frame over the Revelation printable.
- Paste "What is the Open Door?" above door, and "open door" quote below door.
- Use white paint marker and draw an arrow from the bottom of "open door" quote to the next page.

Left page:

- Insert tabs into two slits in door and paste inside door.
- Pull tabs until door opens, and paste to the left page.
- Paste "Jesus is the Door" quote over tabs.

Pages 3 & 4:

Paste on pages:

- Moons-
 - Hole punch both large moons where indicated. Attach to lower ring in binder.
 - Paste Philadelphia moon on left page, and Laodicea moon on right page.
 - Cut the two black rectangle printables. Paste to the back of stairsteps and tree printables. Fold to create lift-the-flaps, and paste to both moons.
 - Fold tab for “The Lapover” printable and paste to left moon.
- Fold “Strait is the gate” printable in half. Paste “What is the water?” printable on outside to make door.
- Paste all printables on left and right pages according to picture guide.
- Use white paint marker to draw lines and arrows to match guide.
- Use white gel pen to write “Had Jesus’ Name” over first three church age moons, and “Lost His Name” over Thyatira moon.
- Write church age dates over each moon.
- Fill in the blanks on pages.



Answer Key:

- “...every evil that was in that first church, lapped over into the next one. Just kept going on down until finally it ends up in complete apostasy in the last day.”
- “What is the water? The gate, the door.”
- “...And at the end of the Laodicean Church Age when she laps over in and spreads out into Eternity then.”
