**The seam allowance throughout the project will be 1/4", along the presser foot edge, unless told otherwise.







 \bigcirc Iron both sides wrong sides together, pressing the fabric away from the zipper. Switch to a zipper foot on your machine. Top stitch, Aining up the presser foot with the edge 7. of the zipper. Fold the outside piece to the right side of the zip- $1 \bigcirc$ per, meeting at the raw edge. Fold the lining piece to the wrong side of the zipper, meeting at the raw edge. Pin together. stitch along the edge, using the zipper foot as a 1) Flip the bag to where Iron the fabrics the lining fabric is on open and top stitch the other zipper side. the outside and close the zipper. Center the zipper and pin the bottom of the zipper side together.
