The Revelation of Jesus Christ Study Binder Instructions

Supplies used:

- Printables Cut out each piece.
- 3 Sheets of Black Cardstock
- 1 Piece of Gold Cardstock
- White Cardstock or Printer Paper for printing
- 1 Sheet of Vellum Paper
- Matte Black Gaff Tape
- Toothpick
- Double-Sided Tape
- Adhesive Foam Dots (to attach any stickers you'd like)
- 3-hole Punch
- Scissors
- Glue
- Glue Stick
- Craft Brad
- ¼" wide Red Ribbon
- Journaling supplies: Pens, colored pencils, fine tip markers, chalk markers, crayons, or highlighters

VELLUM PRINTING TIPS:

If the vellum is not going through the printer correctly, lightly tape the piece of vellum to a regular piece of printer paper. This helps the printer pull the vellum through the printer without jamming. If possible, place the vellum in the manual or rear paper tray. Print out the Printables-Vellum file onto this vellum paper. Carefully detach the vellum paper from the printer paper.







Set up your pages


Reminder: Refer to pictures for placement.

- 3-hole punch 2 pieces of black cardstock and place in your binder. Leave them open to create a 2-page spread (left and right pages).
- 3-hole punch the vellum Unveiling page and place in the binder between the left and right pages.
- Sealed Boxcar. See video in gallery.
 - \circ Cut a piece of black cardstock in half lengthwise 4 ¼" x 11".
 - Use a 22" piece of black Gaff tape, cut in half lengthwise, to tape one cardstock half to your left page to make a flap.
 - Paste the boxcar pieces to both cardstock halves.
 - 3-hole punch the right side of the second cardstock half and add to your binder between the left and right pages.
 - Center the R seal between the two flaps and paste the left side to the left page. Place a piece of double-sided tape on the right side to keep the flaps closed. (Option: Use Velcro dots to keep the flaps closed.)

Lesson 1:

Paste on the left page:

- Tape title, R, St. John the divine.
- Two pieces of the Book of Revelation, pasted together along the small tab.
- Top of the Scriptures Strip. Make a small fold at the bottom of the strip and glue a toothpick inside. Allow to dry, then roll up the strip to make a scroll.
- Foldable Bible. *See video in gallery.* Fold into a little book. Cut a 5 ½" piece of red ribbon and glue small strip to the back of the Bible to make a bookmark.



- Word Search Book.
 - Cut out a 3 ³/₄" x 9" piece of gold cardstock and paste the Fill-In-The-Blanks piece onto it.
 - \circ ~ Fold along the dashed lines.
 - Paste half of the Word Search title to one flap.
 - Search in The Table app to find the answers.

Lesson 2:

Paste on the left page:

- Sealed Boxcar. See video in gallery.
- Washed Means Loosed, Set and Listen.
- Trivia flip cards. Use scissors or an X-ACTO knife to make holes where indicated. With Revelation on top, attach all five cards together with a craft brad.
- Notice Book. Paste a 3 ¾" x 6 ¾" piece of gold cardstock and a 3 ½" x 6 ¼" piece of printer paper or white cardstock together and fold in half. Write "Notice" on the front.

Paste on the right page:

- Bro. Branham Preaching and Alpha and Omega.
- The Signified Quote and the Brother Branham Picture. Paste together along the small tab.

Answer key:

St. John the divine – A <u>Scribe</u> is a person who writes someone else's words.

Book of Revelation -

- 1. The Church
- 2. Israel, a nation
- 3. Both, together

Foldable Bible –

- 1. "...and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John:"
- 3. "Blessed is he that <u>readeth</u>, and they that <u>hear</u> the words of this prophecy,..."

Word search book -

St. John the divine was the scribe.

The book of <u>Revelation</u> is the revealing of the <u>future</u> of His works.

"...Genesis tells the beginning. Revelation reveals what's going to happen..."

"...the ones who are lovers of the <u>Word</u> of God, that's who the Book was written to, to the <u>Church</u>."

Signified quote -

Rev. 19:10

"And I fell at his feet to worship him.

"...and of thy brethren that have the testimony of <u>Jesus</u>:..."

"...the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

Rev. 22:8-9

"And I John saw these things..."

"...I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things."

"...and of thy brethren the prophets ... "

"...worship God."
