

"Find it on the tape" THE FIFTH SEAL

- Listen to Brother Branham read Revelation 6:9-11 in paragraphs 38-39 of *The Fifth Seal*. Unscramble the words from the Bible verses. You will see numbers under some of the letters, but you won't need to use those until activity number 10.
- Brother Branham has been teaching us so much in these Seals, and he doesn't want us to forget what he's taught us. Listen to paragraph 177. All of these true and false questions are about the four Beasts God sent out to combat the antichrist rider. If you search *The Fifth Seal*, you will be able to find and listen to the answers. Don't forget to circle if it's true or false.
- Who are the souls under the altar? Brother Branham says this is a great "controversy," and he wants you to listen real close. Search this word in *The Fifth Seal* and listen until you hear who the souls are. Listen to paragraphs 223-228 to hear what they were given and why they were blinded. Cut and paste the altar and answers to the worksheet.
- Search "verse 10" in *The Fifth Seal* to hear about the fellowservants and "thy brethren." Listen through paragraph 277. Who are "thy brethren"? Cut and paste the answer to the worksheet. Then listen to paragraph 280.
- Who are the two witnesses or prophets? Search "Moses and Elijah" in *The Fifth Seal* and listen to the first quote that comes up from your search. Now color the phrases on the worksheet that are about Elijah light blue, the phrases that are about Moses yellow, and the phrases that are about BOTH green.

HINT: You can search in The Fifth Seal to find the answers.

- Listen to paragraphs 315-316 and paragraph 320 as you complete the maze connecting all 5 times the spirit of Elijah was on earth.
- Search "one hundredth of one percent" in *The Fifth Seal* and listen to that quote. How small is one-hundredth of one percent (0.01%)? If you divide a square into 100 squares and take ONE of those squares and divide IT into 100 squares then take ONE of those little tiny squares, you will have one-hundredth of one percent of the original square. Reveal the picture hidden in the squares by coloring them in using the color code here: 1= dark green 2= blue 3= light green
- Search this quote in *The Fifth Seal*, press play, then fill in the blank.


