Cabin Tutorial

Tools Needed

- Bandsaw
- Clamps
- Measuring tape
- Sand paper
- Safety glasses
- Pin nail gun
- Table saw (dado Blade)
- Router with 5/8 straight bit

Materials Needed

- Assorted wood
- Wood glue
- Finish
- 5/8 pin nails

*** Parental assistance recommended.

Steps

Optional (dado solid piece of wood and then cut into strips.)

1. Cut eight 7 ½" x 1" x ½" strips of wood.



2. Cut six 5" x 1" x ½" strips of wood.



3. Cut two 5" x ½" x ½" strips of wood.



4. On all 1-inch strips dado a 5/8" x ¼" deep notch a ½" from the ends on top and bottom on all 1-inch strips.



5. Dado a $5/8$ " x $1/4$ " deep notch on the $1/2$ " strips $9 1/2$ " from the ends, just on the top.



6. Glue and pin nail the $7 1/2$ " pieces in the front and back joining the 5" side pieces on forming a rectangle.

7. Cut two 2 " x 6 " x $1/2$ " gables at a 56 degree angle.



8. Dado a $5/8$ " x $1/4$ " notch, 1" from the edge on both sides of the gables.

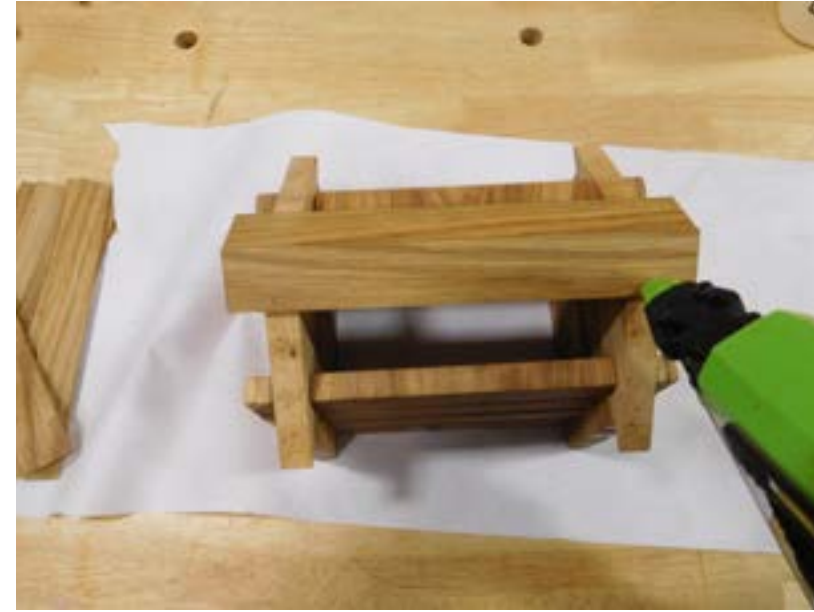
9. Place gables on cabin. ****Note**** Glue and pin nail the gables to the sides if you want the roof permanently attached.



10. Cut eight 1" x 7 1/2" x 1/8" strips.



11. Nail strips to gable starting from the top.



12. Cut and attach desired door and window if wanted.



13. Sand and apply finish.
