Stripe Embellishment



1
cut a
4" by 22"
strip



2
press
under
side
lengths
1/2"



3
pin right sides together,
the towel and the strip
going opposite directions



4
stitch
along
edge of
towel



5
flip strip
over
seam
and
press



6
fold
under
the other
short
end
and pin
around
the strip



7
stitch
1/4"
around
the strip

Pleated Embellishment




Press under the bottom a 1/2" and sew using a 1/4" seam allowance

Press under the sides a 1/2" and sew using a 1/4" seam allowance

Line up the bottom hem to the bottom of the towel and pin across 1" pleats



6

Sew across top using a 1/4" seam allowance.



You can cover the top by a strip or applique.

Applique Embellishment



Roughly cut out desired design out of the fabric

Personalized Towel

Appliquing:

1. Iron interfacing to the back of the fabric where the design is located
2. Cut out the design
3. Pin the design to the towel
4. Stitch around the edge of the design.
Pivot and turn!
