- Top 12 inch x 44-45 inch
- Trim 3 inch x 44-45 inch
- Main fabric 25 inch x 44-45 inch Wonder-under
- Pocket 4 inch x 7 inch
- Cross 2 inch x 2 inch

  - 2 pieces, each 2 inch x 2 inch





# STEPS FOR PILLOW CASE:

- 1. Iron the 3 inch piece in half, wrong sides together.
- Lay the 12 inch piece out right side up. Lay the 3 inch piece on it, matching up the raw edges. Start pinning in the center and work your way to the edges. (Make sure the pieces are centered; we will trim the edges later.)
- 3. Then take the 25 inch piece and lay it right side down on top of the piece you just pinned and center it, matching the raw edges.
- 4. Starting in the center and working your way to the edges, pin it all together.
- 5. Roll up the 25 inch piece until it is about 1.5 inch from the edge you have just pinned.
- 6. Fold the 12 in piece over the top of all the layers.
- 7. Starting in the center and working your way out, pin all the layers together.
- 8. Use a ½ inch seam allowance and sew all the layers together. Don't sew over the pins! Make sure to take the pins out as you come to them.
- 9. Roll back the 12 inch piece and gently pull the 25 inch piece out of the middle.
- 10. Press the 12 inch piece and the 3 inch piece.
- 11. Turn it over and press the 12 inch piece and the 25 inch piece, tugging gently so they will lay flat.
- 12. Fold pillowcase in half, wrong sides together, and match up the seam. Trim off the salvage and even out the bottom.
- 13. With the wrong sides together and the seam matched, pin along the open side and the bottom.
- 14. Using a 3/8 inch seam allowance, sew across the open side and sew off, then turn the pillow case and sew across the bottom, you will sew over the seam you just made, this makes a nice corner.
- 15. Clip the corners of the raw edges.
- 16. Press the seams open.
- 17. Turn the pillowcase so the wrong sides are out and press the seams. You can use a pencil to help turn out the corners.
- 18. Use a ½ inch seam allowance to sew along the side and bottom, remember to sew off and start again when you get to the corner.
- 19. Turn the pillowcase right side out at press.

# STEPS FOR THE POCKET:

### <u>CROSS:</u>

- Trim a square of Wonder-under to slightly smaller than the square of the cross fabric and attach to the wrong side of the fabric according to product directions.
- 2. Trace or draw a cross on the square and then cut the cross out.


#### POCKET:


- 1. Fold the pocket in half, right sides together, and press.
- 2. Fold the top down a  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch on both sides and press.
- 3. Sew up the sides, leave the top open.
- 4. Trim the corners; be careful that you don't cut the seams.
- 5. Turn the pocket right side out and press it, you can use a pencil or the tip of a pair of scissors to poke out the corners.
- 6. Press the pocket.
- 7. Pull the paper backing off of the cross and place the cross, Wonder-under side down, in the center of the pocket. Press.
- 8. Place a prayer cloth inside the pocket and center it behind the cross. You can use a pin to help hold it all together.
- 9. Using a zigzag stitch that is wide and close together, sew around the cross, making sure to catch the prayer cloth between both sides of the pocket.

# ATTACHING POCKET TO THE PILLOW CASE:

- 1. Apply a piece of Wonder-under to the back of the pocket.
- 2. Take the paper backing off the pocket and decide where you want the pocket on the pillowcase.
- 3. Apply the Wonder-under side of the pocket to the pillowcase.
- 4. Use a zigzag stitch to sew around all sides of the pocket (make sure to only sew on one layer of the pillowcase, you don't want to sew it shut!)


