PIN AND CUT
OUT THE LINER



Step 8

SEW THEN SERGE THE
SIDE SEAMS OF THE
LINER WITH A 1/4"
SEAM ALLOWANCE



TURN RIGHT SIDES OUT. PRESS
SIDE SEAMS OPEN AND SERGE THE
BOTTOM AND TOP EDGES



(FINISHED ADD ON LENGTH)



CUT EACH RUFFLE TO THE DESIRED
WIDTH BY ABOUT DOUBLE THE LENGTH
OF AROUND THE SKIRT BOTTOM



Step 12

SERGE AROUND EACH
RUFFLE PIECE

SEW SHORT ENDS OF EACH FABRIC PRINT
RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER, PRESS OPEN

Step 13

FOR A FINISHED HEM, PRESS AND TURN
UP ONE LENGTH OF EACH RUFFLE AND
SEW USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE

Step 14

SEW A GATHERING
STITCH AROUND THE
LENGTH OF EACH
RUFFLE WITH A 1/4"
SEAM ALLOWANCE,
GATHER



Step 15

PIN OVERLAPPING THE BOTTOM OF THE
LINER. WHEN YOU GET TO WHERE THE TWO
ENDS MEET, TRIM ONE END TO MAKE A 3"
EXCESS ON BOTH ENDS

Step 16

PIN RIGHT SIDES
TOGETHER THEN
SEW AND
SERGE
RAW EDGE,
THIS MAY BE
AWKWARD

SEW DOWN USING A
1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE

REPEAT STEPS
WITH THE SECOND
RUFFLE, PINNING
THE BOTTOM
OVERLAPPING THE
TOP OF THE BOTTOM





REPEAT STEPS WITH THE TOP RUFFLE, PINNING THE BOTTOM OVERLAPPING THE TOP OF THE SECOND RUFFLE



Step 20

PIN THE BOTTOM OF THE SKIRT OVERLAPPING THE TOP OF THE RUFFLE PIECE ABOUT 5/8", SEW USING A 1/2" SEAM ALLOWANCE




IF YOU DON'T WANT A RAW EDGE, PIN THE RUFFLED PIECE AND THE SKIRT BOTTOM RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND SEW USING A 1/2" SEAM ALLOWANCE

Full Flounce Template



PRESS THE FABRIC



Step 2

MEASURE THE LENGTH AND WIDTH OF THE SLIT



CUT A RECTANGLE 2" TALLER THAN THE LENGTH OF THE SLIT AND 4" WIDER THAN THE SLIT

Step 3



Step 4

OPEN UP THE SLIT AND CUT A TRIANGLE 1" WIDER AND TALLER THAN THE SLIT OPENING



Step 5

CENTER THE TRIANGLE ON THE RECTANGLE



Step 6

USING A RULER, CUT THE RECTANGLE ANGLE AND PARALLEL TO THE TRIANGLE PIECE, ABOUT 1" AWAY




Step 7

REPEAT ON BOTH SIDES OF THE TRIANGLE, SERGE ALL THE PIECES



Step 8

PIN RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER, EACH SIDE AT A TIME. SEW USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE



PRESS OPEN SEAMS CUT OFF ANY EXCESS AT THE TOP AND SERGE. MARK THE TOP CENTER OF THE PIECE

TURN THE BOTTOM UNDER 1/4" AND SEW





TURN THE SKIRT INSIDE OUT AND PIN THE INSERT TO THE SLIT EDGES



SEW USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE

TURN SKIRT RIGHT SIDES OUT. FOLD THE SKIRT WHERE THE SLIT IS CLOSED AND PIN THE TOP OF THE SLIT, CATCHING THE TOP OF THE INSERT



Step 14

TURN SKIRT INSIDE OUT, LAY OUT THE SKIRT, KEEPING THE SLIT OPENING CLOSED.



Step 15

FOLD THE TOP SIDES INTO THE CENTER, REMOVE THE PIN FROM THE FRONT, AND PIN





