8. I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept My Word, and hast not denied My Name.

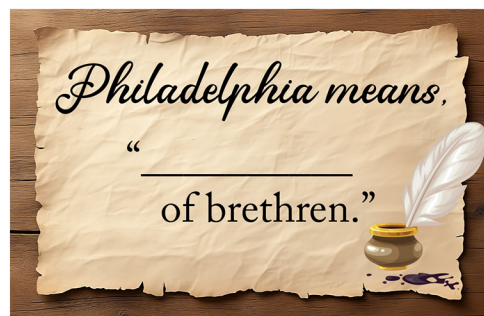
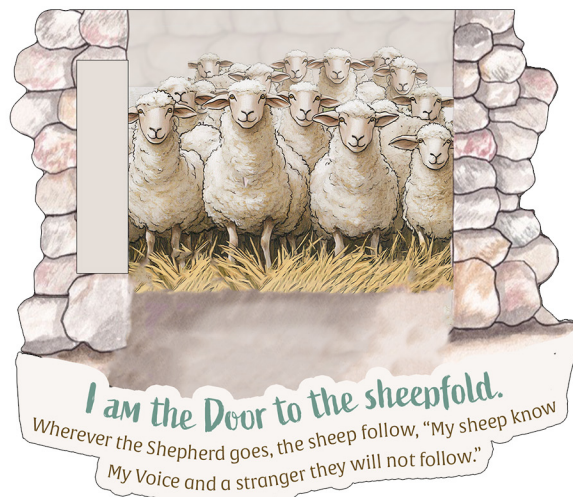
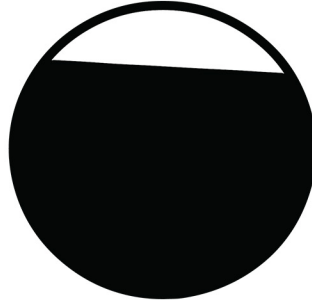

11. Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

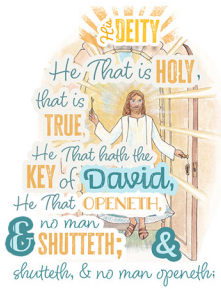

13. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

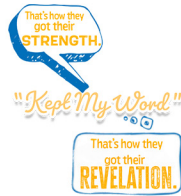

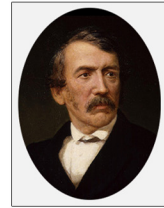
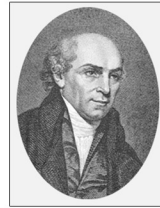
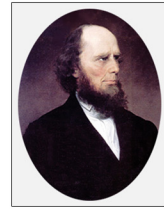
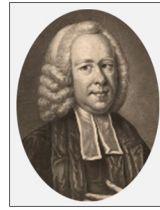
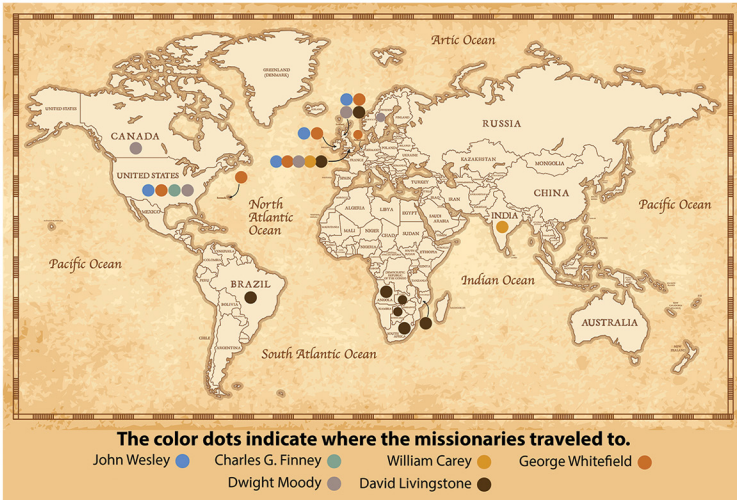
- ★ John Wesley was born at Epworth, England on June 17th, 1703.

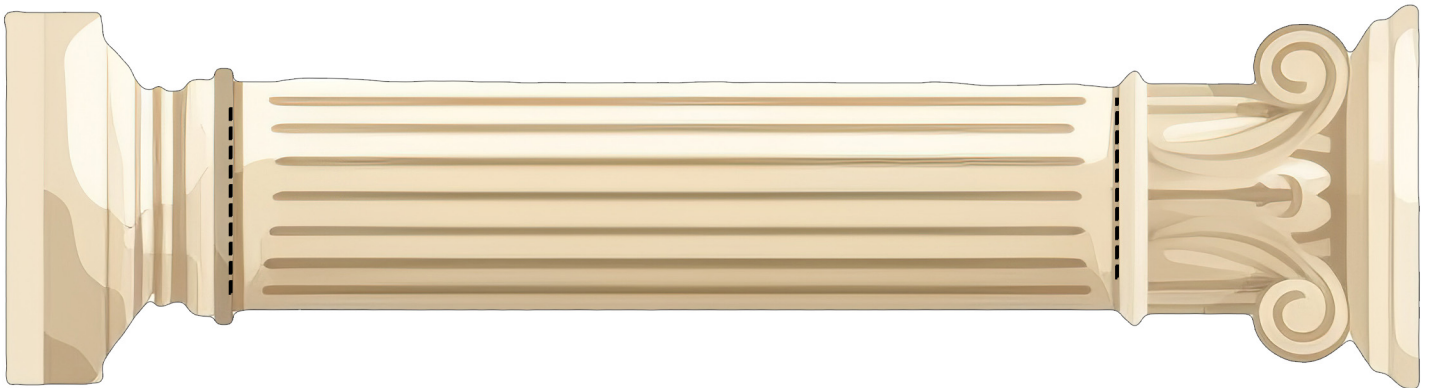
