8. I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept My Word, and hast not denied My Name.



11. Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.





That tassel age was the Wesleyan Age. They were the greatest missionaries and even excelled us in our age. What did that age do? It scattered like pollen in the breeze.






- ★ John Wesley was born at Epworth. England on June 17th. 1703.
- His father was a preacher.



- He was called a "methodist" because of his methods of doing things.





