

SUPPLIES:

- Gold String- 12 inches Gold Jump Rings- 4 (14mm)
- · Printable Templates
- Clay tools (rolling pin and cutter)
- Scissors

Polymer Clay

- .1 oz White
- .5 oz Yellow
- .5 oz Orange
- 1.5 oz White
- - Boys (option 1) · 1 oz Navy Blue
 - Boys (option 2) · 1 oz Cobalt Blue Girls
 - 1 oz Lilac



- · .4 oz Navy Blue
- .4 oz Teal .4 oz Light Blue
- Pyramid-Boys
- (option 2)
 .4 oz Turquoise · .4 oz Cobalt Blue .4 oz Mint

- 1. Roll out orange clay, yellow clay, and white clay into logs. Roll yellow and orange clay into 4" logs. Roll white clay into about a 2" log.
- 2. Place white clay in the middle, then circle yellow clay around the white, and orange clay around the yellow. Trim as needed.
- 3. Squeeze around the edges to connect the clay together. Using small rolling pin, roll over POF. Place clay on top of template and shape clay to match template.
- 4. Using wooden stick, poke a hole in the top and bottom of POF.

Cloud:

- 1. Roll out white clay into a long log and shape into a circle.
- 2. Place Cloud template on top of clay and shape clay to match template.
- 3. Trim around template as needed to make Cloud shape.
- 4. Using wooden stick, poke a hole in the top and bottom of Cloud.

Pyramid:

- 1. Roll all your colors out into 4" logs.
- 2. Cut 2 colors in half and 1 color into 3 pieces. Stack all the pieces together to create 7 logs.
- 3. Use rolling pin and roll out Pyramid to connect pieces together.
- 4. Put Pyramid template on top of clay and cut out.
- 5. Using wooden stick, poke a hole in the top and bottom of Pyramid.

- 1. Roll clay into a ball and roll out into a circle. Place over template to make sure you have the size right.
- 2. Using wooden R, press into clay to make an R imprint.
- 3. Using wooden stick, poke a hole in the top of R.

Finishing up:

- 1. Line up your clay pieces in a straight line.
- 2. Using your wooden kebab stick, poke a hole in the top and bottom of POF, Cloud, and Pyramid. Poke a hole in the top of R.

Note: Poke your holes as close to the edge of your clay pieces as you can without breaking clay.

Baking:

- 1. Place clay pieces on parchment paper-lined baking sheet. Bake pieces at 275F for 10 minutes. Po not overbake to avoid burning clay. PO NOT MICROWAVE. Allow to cool.
- 2. Connect pieces together with gold rings.
- 3. Thread gold string through the ring at the top of the POF and tie a knot.
